

TOMHAVE GRIP

A method for gripping a golf club. Description and images are for a right hand dominant player.

Left Hand - Hand furthest from the club head and applied to the club first.

Digit 5(pinky), Digit 4(ring), and Digit 3(middle), grip around the shaft.

Digit 2(index) overlaps the right hand laying on top of the juncture of right hand digits 3 and 4. (While placing right hand, this finger is held up out of the way.)

Digit 1(thumb) placed on the top of the shaft opposite of finger knuckles.

Right Hand - Hand nearest the club head and applied with digit 3 next to, touching and aligned with left digit 3.

Digit 5(pinky) overlaps mid left hand on top of the juncture of left hand digits 3 and 4

Digit 4(ring), Digit 3(middle), and Digit 2(index), grip around the shaft

Digit 1(thumb) placed on top of the shaft opposite of finger knuckles, slightly overlapping the left thumb. Thenar eminence atop of left thumb base.



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
