Contamination - Clubhouse/Changing Facilities	Contracting the virus through commonly used surfaces such as (but not restricted to):- Touch/keypad entry systems, door handles, push pads, lockers, toilet facilities, toilet flush/seats, hand-washing facilities, taps, handrails.	Access to the clubhouse/changing rooms is only permitted for use of toilet facilities. Toilet facilities and entry points to access toilets are regularly disinfected and inspected by staff. Hand sanitiser and disinfectant spray is available in key points where the public need to have access to toilet facilities. One way system in operation around/through club house.	Low	
Contamination - Contact With People	Contracting the virus through person to person contact	Golfers are instructed to comply with Government guidelines for social distancing (currently 2 metres) at all times. Tee booking is made by phone. The maximum number of 2 golfers in a group per tee time is in accordance with government requirements at the	Low	

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given time. Golfers are requested to pre-book tee times to maintain safety measures. Payment is taken on-line or phone. Play is managed by office and volunteers on each starting hole. A minimum of 10 minute intervals between tee times is allocated. Marshalls are employed to monitor golfers behaviour on the course. Limited essential access (eg toilets) is available. Golfers are advised in advance to remain in their cars upon arrival at the facility until a set time prior to their tee time. The Pro-shop is currently closed. Procedures are in place for the practice putting green to facilitate social distancing. Golfers are requested to leave the premises as quickly as possible to minimise social gatherings.

Contamination - Course Equipment

Contracting the virus through surface contact with course furniture including but not limited to:- flagsticks, rakes,

Golfers are instructed use hand sanitiser prior to and whilst visiting the golf course. All rakes and ball retrievers are

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ball retrievers, ball washers, drinking fountains, benches, bins, gates and any other relevant equipment.

removed from the course. Ball washers and drinking fountains are covered up (out of use). Benches and bins are removed. All other removable items are removed from the course. Flagsticks are retained but players have been instructed not to touch. A method of inserting the hole liner is adopted to prevent the ball falling below the surface of the putting green, which enables the ball to be easily retrieved by handling only the ball itself. Practice areas are only open when safe sanitising practices can be guaranteed. Access gates are left open where & when possible. Access gates are regularly disinfected.

Contamination - Personal Equipment

Contracting the virus through contact with items including but not limited to:- Golf balls, bags, trolleys, scorecards, rangefinders, mobile phones,

Golfers are instructed to only touch their own equipment. Golfers are not permitted to share any equipment. Golfers are instructed to carry hand sanitiser in case of
