

JINGLE JAMS

Ages 6-8 years old, max. 6 students per class

JAM BAND 101 is a game-based, songwriting-centered class that inspires collaboration and communication through music. Kids learn music fluencies, practice basic instrument technique, gain confidence in their creativity and find joy in music.

Through music games and songwriting, students learn core fluencies (rhythm, harmony, melody, and songwriting) and explore rock band band instruments (piano, guitar, bass, drums, and vocals).

Jam Band 101 is perfect for beginners or kids with 1-2 years of band or lesson experience. Kids who do well in Jam Band 101 are excited to try out all the instruments and enjoy learning in a group setting.



In January and May, participants in Mini Keys and Jam Band 101 will perform their original songs for friends and family.

MINIKEYS is a game-based group class and a perfect launch pad for a student's musical journey. We explore piano, drums, and voice and write original songs in our band.



MiniKeys is perfect for total beginners or those aging out of Music Together[®]. Kids who do well in MiniKeys are excited to try out all the instruments and enjoy playing games and learning in a group setting.



SONGSTERS

Ages 7-9, maximum 6 students

A 12-week group class with Erin Bustin introduces young children to singing and music literacy. Interactive, play-based lessons use animal-themed games and songs to help singers discover their voices, build singing confidence, and learn foundational music skills. Appropriate for beginners or those with some experience singing in lessons or choir. Songsters will perform in the studio-wide GSoM Recital on Sunday, February 9.

MOVING TO THE SOUNDS AROUND YOU

Weekly private lessons are our most popular program. Tuition assumes 30 lessons throughout the school year (September 3, 2024 - May 30, 2025), paid in equal monthly installments. Enrollment is ongoing, pending teacher availability and scheduling.
