Reed Gold Mine is the site of the first documented gold find in the United States. From this discovery, gold mining spread gradually to nearby counties and eventually into other southern states. A visitor center, trails, and self-guided mine tour are available for free. Daily guided tours of the mine and gold panning are available for a small fee.
