Loaner Program Policy

- 1. The VFA Guild maintains a Loan List of guild equipment available
- 2. The Loan List will be posted on the website.
- 3. All guild members are eligible to use the items on the Loan List.
- 4. Loan will be made available for a mutually agreed upon time period.
- 5. An extension may be granted if the equipment is not in demand.

6. The member-borrower will complete a loaner form and sign an agreement to care for the equipment and return it in good condition at the end of the loan period.

7. To inquire about borrowing equipment, contact the designated board member.
