### Service Projects:

#### • Military Projects:

- Adopt-a-Squadron We adopted a Marine squadron (<u>HMLA 369</u>) and their families at Camp Pendleton. We participate in numerous activities to support the single Marines and the married Marine families. Chair: <u>Jean S</u>
- o **Fisher House** provides housing for military families while a loved one is in the hospital. Chair: Jean S

- Interfaith Community Services is a facility offering a variety of services for the unhoused in North County San Diego. We have several volunteer projects:
  - Members collect small hotel-size toiletries, and during a pre meeting activity, we bag toiletries which are provided to Interfaith (Save all your hotel toiletries for Gina!) Chair: Gina E
