The builder or roofing contractor must confirm in writing that the weatherproofing is in good order or specify what work needs to be done to rectify the identified defects. Any defects identified, must be rectified within one month by **you** at **your** expense.

If you do not comply with this condition you will not be covered and we will not make any payment in respect of a claim for storm or accidental damage from ingress of water
