Job Summary:

Under the supervision of the Executive Director the Child and Youth Coordinator will provide immediate and ongoing culturally based counselling services, recreational activities to clients and their children to assist them in transitioning from the immediate crisis to healing and rebuilding their parental relationship. Other duties and responsibilities are as follows but not limited to:

- Working in a highly confidential/team-based environment while keeping the Executive Director and Crisis Interveneors well informed of the children's needs, progress and barriers.
- Document and safeguard all relevant information pertaining to the children while they reside at Gignoo.
- Identify needs and barriers and provide resources and services to mothers.
- Provide childcare for mothers when they have meetings/appointments.
- Serve as an advocate for children and youth at Gignoo. Make referrals to community-based services, child protection and other public agencies on the child's behalf as required.

Qualifications.

Degree or Diploma in Child and Youth Care or Early Childhood Education. Or someone who can demonstrated relevant experience in working with children and youth who've experienced trauma or who struggle with behavioral or mental health concerns.

Preference will be given to Indigenous applicants and those with experience in working with First Nations.

Relief Crisis Intervener

Job Summary:

Under the supervision of the Lead Crisis Counsellor, the Relief Crisis Intervenor is responsible for working with women who have been experiencing intimate partner violence by providing support and resources to aid in their transition. In addition to working with residents the Relief Crisis Intervener participates in telephone counselling and works with women who drop into the house for advice and/or counselling.

Qualifications:

High school diploma, First Aid, Criminal Record Check with the vulnerable sector. Experience is an asset but not necessary.

Training can be provided.
