Chairman's Report:

Dave explained Norman's role in assisting Amy as treasurer, Norman explained that he could be contactable whilst he is away later in the year if Amy had any queries.

Dave stated that he has applied for Hall and Woodhouse Community Chest Grant with view of the money going towards repairs to the roof. Dave discovered that a town council grant can be applied for, Sharon to action this. Dave recently learnt that the Winterbourne group's equipment will shortly be vacating our premises.

Treasurer's Report:

The balance to date 22/04/18 was £12,933.76, the bingo held in March raised £534.10 this direct debit will be transferred shortly. Sharon to send a letter of thanks to Damory Veterinary Clinic for their sponsorship.

Group Scout Leader's Report:

The St. George's Day parade went well, there will be a Dippy sleepover on Saturday in Dorchester museum. The beavers are now permitted to camp without parents, a camp will take place at Fernecrofts in the New Forest which beavers and cubs will be attending. Leaders will need permits to qualify.

Scouts Report:

The scouts are involved in lots of camps, cycling sleep overs and the Jurassic Jamboree.

Georgian Fayre:

A new tombola barrel has been made for all to use, Amy to sort out a float, Sharon to find out the location of the pitch and if car registrations are needed. The road will close at 7.00 a.m. and all stalls must be set up by 8.45 ready for the opening at 9.00 a.m.

A.G.M.:
