Review last minutes; We still haven't heard from Pete Warrington in regards to his position of Group President but in the current situation this is understandable. Just Giving Page required a monthly fee of $\pounds 15$ to set up a page, RR understands that this should be available for free and is pursuing it further.

Treasurers Report; The badge costs have been reallocated since our last meeting to the correct sections. We should promote Amazon prime via FB ahead of Christmas purchasing to maximise any revenue. This is now available via the phone app.

GSL Report; CB was welcomed to the meeting and presented the GSL report that is attached.
