This code of conducts applies to all parents and guardians. Any breach thereof shall be subject to disciplinary action, may be expelled from the premises and not be allowed into future events.

- Do not coach your child during training sessions and games, that's what the coaches are there for. It sends mixed messages to the players and creates confusion.
- Do not interfere with training sessions.
- Cheer on and encourage players at all times, even the opposition, applaud good play all round.
- Winning at all costs isn't everything, we have a responsibility to develop players and at this age learning is more important than winning.
- Remember that children play sport for their own enjoyment, not yours.
- Encourage children to participate, don't force them.
- Focus on the team's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- Remember that children learn best by example, applaud good play by all teams.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Respect the decisions made by officials and teach children to do likewise.
- Show appreciation of coaches, officials and club representatives. Without them your child could not participate.
- Respect the facilities that have been provided.
- Keep clear from technical areas, benches and changing rooms during games or tournaments. This is the ideal time for coaches to teach players without interference.
