#### **Ash Wednesday Service**

The season of Lent is a time of preparation for the celebration of Holy Week and Easter. During the 40 days of Lent, we go on a journey with Jesus to the cross. It is a time in which we can reflect upon our faith and what it means for us to proclaim "Christ, and him crucified" as our confession of faith.

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on February 22. That night we will hold a special worship service in which we will have the opportunity to ask God to create in us a clean heart and put a new and right spirit within us. After a time of prayer and scripture, we will have the opportunity to receive the mark of the ashes upon our foreheads as a reminder that our bodies come from dust and will return to dust, but our souls and spirits will live forever.

Please plan now to join together for our Ash Wednesday service on February 22. The service will begin at 7:00.

#### **Bible Study Returns!**

Have you ever had anyone ask you what the Moravian church believes? If so, and if you want to be able to give them a good answer, then join us for our Wednesday evening Bible Study during the season of Lent.

During the weeks between Ash Wednesday and Palm Sunday we will be taking a closer look at the Easter Morning Liturgy of the Moravian Church. This liturgy is the most comprehensive confession of faith for the Moravian Church. Each Wednesday evening we will use the liturgy to help us better understand what it means to be a Moravian and to help us prepare for Easter Sunday when we joyfully proclaim "The Lord is risen! The Lord is risen indeed!"

The study will begin on Wednesday March 1 at 6:30 and will take place each Wednesday evening in March.

#### Palm Sunday, Holy Week, and Easter

Holy Week begins on Sunday April 2 with our Palm Sunday Worship service. Join us for worship at 11:00 as we sing together *Hosanna*, *blessed is he that comes!* and celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

Our journey through the events of the last week of Jesus' earthly life continues each night with our Holy Week Reading Services. On Sunday April 2, Monday April 3, Tuesday April 4, and Wednesday April 5 we will worship together as we hear the stories and sing the songs that tell of what Jesus said and did as the week unfolded.

On Maundy Thursday (April 6) we will share in a special service of Holy Communion as we remember the last supper that Jesus shared with his disciples.

Good Friday (April 7) will feature two services. At 2:15 we will share in the Crucifixion Service as we complete our journey to the cross with Jesus and join in mourning as we hear the words of the cross and experience the death of our Lord. That evening, we will conclude our Holy Week services with our Good Friday Lovefeast at 7:00.

The Lord is risen! Easter Sunday will begin bright and early with our Easter Sunrise Service. In this service we will pray together the Easter Morning Liturgy, the Moravian confession of faith, in which we share our belief in God, our Creator, Redeemer, and Sustainer. The service will begin in front of the church and conclude in God's Acre. The time is yet to be determined. Our Easter Worship Service will begin at 11:00 as we once again proclaim that the Lord is risen indeed!
