



Time With Br. Duke Marley



(Sister Sarah and Brother Duke Marley)

Br. Duke Marley was born in Cumberland, Maryland on April 13th, 1931. He was an only child. Early on in life, he was given the nickname "Duke" after the Duke Hotel in Durham, NC where his parents spent their honeymoon.

Duke's father was Baptist, and his mother was Methodist, so he was raised in the Church from birth. Sometimes he would attend a Presbyterian Church, but when he was told that animals did not go to Heaven, he left and didn't go back.

Duke attended Bob Jones University where he joined the Army Reserves. Later, he saw service in the Korean War (in England near the North Sea where it was very cold), in Vietnam (as a supply officer), and in the US, serving 50 years total. He retired as a colonel.

After the Korean War, Duke attended Elon Collene where he met Sarah on a blind date. They married (and have been for over 70 years) and began Army life together. They moved 15 times during those years. Sarah did not work outside of the home but cared for their three children. They now enjoy six grandchildren. Always busy, after retirement Duke rebuilt four different Hudson Cars. He also continued his volunteer work, backstage work, which he started while at Elon.

After Duke and Sarah moved to Kapp Road, they decided to attend Bethania Moravian Church. Duke quickly became involved in the car shows, the Men's Fellowship, visiting the sick, and in the quilting ministry. Because Duke was always willing to ask for donations, the quilters obtained a car upholstery machine, a serger, and many bolts of fabric. Duke made many, many bags for the homeless, and donated to many causes monetarily.

Duke misses the people of Bethania Moravian and reminds us that our prayer life is most important. When his health declines, he moved to assisted living in Lexington where they fondly refer to him as "The Colonel".








