IN CONSIDERATION, therefore, for the privilege of riding and/or working around horses at Tri-Brook Equestrian Center, the undersigned does hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify Tri-Brook Equestrian Center instructor, Regina Ennis, and further release them from any liability or responsibility for accident, damage, injury, or illness to the Undersigned or any horse owned by the Undersigned or to any family member or spectator accompanying the Undersigned while on the premises of Tri-Brook Equestrian Center; and that except in the event of this equestrian center or riding instructors gross and willful negligence, I shall bring NO claims, demands, actions, and cause of action, and/or property damage sustained by me and/or my minor child or legal ward in relation to the premises and operations of this Equestrian Center and or its instructor, Regina Ennis, including while riding, handling or otherwise being near horses owned by or in the care, custody and control of the equestrian center.

I, the Undersigned, understand that Tri-Brook Equestrian Center and Regina Ennis have advised me that while mounted on the property of Tri-Brook Equestrian Center and during a riding lesson with Regina Ennis, that the Rider must wear an ASTM approved riding helmet and proper foot wear.
