Our Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes how Bold Moves Boss, LLC collects, uses, and discloses your Personal Information when you visit or make a purchase from the Service or website.

Collecting Personal Information

When you visit the Service website, we collect certain information about your device, your interaction with the Service, and information necessary to process your purchases or subscription. We may also collect additional information if you contact us for customer support.

In this Privacy Policy, we refer to any information that can uniquely identify an individual (including the information below) as "Personal Information". See the list below for more information about what Personal Information we collect and why.

Device information

- Examples of Personal Information collected: version of web browser, IP address, time zone, cookie information, what websites, services or products you view, search terms, and how you interact with the Service website. - Purpose of collection: to load the Service website accurately for you, and to perform analytics on the Service website usage to optimize our Services. - Source of collection: Collected automatically when you access our Service website using cookies, log files, web beacons, tags, or pixels. - Disclosure for a business purpose: shared with our processor GoDaddy.

Order information

- Examples of Personal Information collected: name, billing address, shipping address, payment information (including credit card numbers, email address, and phone number. - Purpose of collection: to provide products or services to you to fulfill our contract, to process your payment information, arrange for shipping, and provide you with invoices and/or order confirmations, communicate with you, screen our orders for potential risk or fraud, and when in line with the preferences you have shared with us, provide you with information or advertising relating to our products or services. - Source of collection: collected from you. - Disclosure for a business purpose: shared with our processor GoDaddy and payments provider Stripe.

Customer support information

- Examples of Personal Information collected - Purpose of collection: to provide customer support. - Source of collection: collected from you.

Minors

We do not intentionally collect Personal Information from children. If you are the parent or guardian and believe your child has provided us with Personal Information, please contact us at the address below to request deletion.

Sharing Personal Information

We share your Personal Information with relevant connected services to help us provide our services and fulfill our contracts with you, as described above.

- We use GoDaddy to power our website and service. You can read more about how GoDaddy uses your Personal Information here: <u>https://www.GoDaddy.com/privacy</u> - We use Stripe to process all payments related to purchases and subscriptions. - We may share your Personal Information to comply with applicable laws and regulations, to respond to a subpoena, search warrant or other lawful request for information we receive, or to otherwise protect our rights.

Behavioural Advertising

As described above, we use your Personal Information to provide you with targeted advertisements or marketing communications we believe may be of interest to you.

Using Personal Information

We use your Personal Information to provide our services to you, which includes: offering services and products for sale, processing payments, and subscriptions, and keeping you up to date on new products, services, and offers.

Lawful basis

Pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"), if you are a resident of the European Economic Area ("EEA"), we process your personal information under the following lawful bases:

- Your consent; - The performance of the contract between you and the Service website; - Compliance with our legal obligations; - To protect your vital interests; - To perform a task carried out in the public interest; - For our legitimate interests, which do not override your fundamental rights and freedoms.

Retention

When you purchase a service or sign up for a subscription on The Service, we will retain your Personal Information for our records unless and until you ask us to erase this information. For more information on your right of erasure, please see the 'Your rights' section below.

Automatic decision-making

If you are a resident of the EEA, you have the right to object to processing based solely on automated decision-making (which includes profiling), when that decision-making has a legal effect on you or otherwise significantly affects you.

We do not engage in fully automated decision-making that has a legal or otherwise significant effect using customer data

Our processor GoDaddy uses limited automated decision-making to prevent fraud that does not have a legal or otherwise significant effect on you.

Services that include elements of automated decision-making include:

- Temporary denylist of IP addresses associated with repeated failed transactions. This denylist persists for a small number of hours. - Temporary denylist of credit cards associated with deny listed IP addresses. This denylist persists for a small number of days.

Your rights

GDPR

If you are a resident of the EEA, you have the right to access the Personal Information we hold about you, to port it to a new service, and to ask that your Personal Information be corrected, updated, or erased. Cookies

A cookie is a small amount of information that's downloaded to your computer or device when you visit our Service website. We use a number of different cookies, including functional, performance, advertising, and social media or content cookies. Cookies make your browsing experience better by allowing the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login and region selection). This means you don't have to re-enter this information each time you return to the site or browse from one page to another. Cookies also provide information on how people use the website, for instance, whether it's their first time visiting or if they are a frequent visitor.

The length of time that a cookie remains on your computer or mobile device depends on whether it is a "persistent" or "session" cookie. Session cookies last until you stop browsing and persistent cookies last until they expire or are deleted. Most of the cookies we use are persistent and will expire between 30 minutes and two years from the date they are downloaded to your device.

You can control and manage cookies in various ways. Please keep in mind that removing or blocking cookies can negatively impact your user experience and parts of our Service website may no longer be fully accessible.

Additionally, please note that blocking cookies may not completely prevent how we share information with third parties such as our advertising partners. To exercise your rights or opt-out of certain uses of your information by these parties, please follow the instructions in the "Behavioural Advertising" section above.

Do Not Track

Please note that because there is no consistent industry understanding of how to respond to "Do Not Track" signals, we do not alter our data collection and usage practices when we detect such a signal from your browser.
