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Traditionalist values are declining in America as fewer attend Church and culture wanes

About 3 in 10 American adults now self-identify as religiously unaffiliated, a new study from the Pew Research Center found, reinforcing the notion that Americans are becoming more secular in the 21st century.

Since the turn of the century, there has been a near doubling in the percentage of traditionalists (from 4% to 7%), baby boomers (from 7% to 13%) and Gen Xers (11% to 20%) with no religious affiliation.

As a kid we had very little and yet I was optimistic. We didn't have street lights in our rural barrio and nights were scary. Growing up without indoor plumbing or TV seems hard now, but I had nothing to compare it to. Mom's radio only played Mexican music so my childhood heroes were smart alecks Mariachis. They fought injustice, triumphed over evil, and loved long haired beautiful brown eyed women. Pedro Infante, Jorge Negrete, Cantinflas, El Piporro, Tin Tan, Antonio Aguilar and Maria Felix are amongst the few I remember. I grew up loving horses, guns, mariachi music and the outdoors. Sitting around our backyard campfire listening to my father's friends we overheard stories of the Mexican Revolution and America's Wars. We learned of fighting wolves with slings and knives, of being lost and being attacked by fighting bulls in Mexico. We learned about industrial accidents, sinking ships, dying men and crying women. The world outside our barrio seemed frightening and terrible. Mom listened to the radio as she sang and hung the laundry under the Blue Texas Skies as I made mud balls and played. On movie night my older sisters made a grocery bag of popcorn, filled water bottles, grabbed blankets, mosquito repellent and waited.

When dad arrived, we'd pile into our station wagon and make the long drive into town to The Buccaneer Drive Inn. The trip was exciting as I looked out the window in awe of the world. Even today, I can sometimes still taste my sister's homemade popcorn. The movies nurtured me in ways I never fully understood. They encouraged me to be expressive and overcome my stuttering. The movies brought friends to the lonely, hope to the shy and opened passages for the lost. They said someone without a dime could win the love of his life. Of course, it was pure mythical movie magic but it worked. My imagination whirled and rose like a beautiful, often painful storm that brought tears, hope and sunshine. No matter how bad things got, the good people always prevailed.

Movies took me over mountains and across oceans and rivers. They sparked my curiosity about foreign countries, languages and people. Hidden in the darkness of the old Buccaneer Drive Inn I cried and laughed. I experienced fear and inspiration so much so that I secretly fell in love with Maria Felix, a famous fiery Mexican star




who became my standard for women. I grew up imagining long-haired Mexican beauties with beautiful smiles, almond shaped eyes and rose red lips. Movies had a positive influence that promoted religion, love of country and morals. Traditional values and appreciation for our culture was nourished in all of our family gatherings. There seemed to be less chaos and evil doings in those days.

We should all be concerned about the current shift away from religion and traditional values. Americans

were leaving the church and religious ties long before Covid and the move has accelerated over the past three decades, the percentage of Americans who do not identify with any religion has grown from 8% in 1998-2000 to 13% in 2008-2010 and 21% over the past several years. Recent restrictions and concerns related to Covid have impacted church attendance; however, the downward trend is independent of concern over covid. Only a quarter of Americans attend weekly religious services now, with Black evangelicals leading at 57%. Half of Protestants and about one-third of Catholics said they attend religious services at least monthly.

Twenty-seven percent of Americans said they never attend religious services, and nearly a third seldom or never pray. Fewer than half pray daily today.

While we may not be able to change the religious affiliations and practices of our nation I have some advice. A movie I found especially inspiring was The Miracle of Marcelino first released in 1955. The movie impacted the world causing multiple assertions of miracles around the globe. It was translated into a dozen languages and remade in 1991. It reawakened our childhood innocence and renewed our faith in a failing God.

AMERICA MUST STAND BEHIND ITS WORKERS SAYS BERNIE!

By Dr. José A. Flores Senator Bernie Sanders rallied workers and encouraged Kellogg's to negotiate a fair settlement and stop engaging in unionbusting activities underway there in December. Union workers at Kellogg's gained a settlement after a 77 day strike. A \$1.10 cents per hour for all employees among many other concessions ended the strike.

According to Senator Bernie Sanders America's income and wealth inequality is at its highest in 100 years. "After adjusting for inflation, the average worker in America is making \$40 dollars a week less today than he/she made 48 years ago. The result: millions of working-class families are struggling to pay for [health care](#), prescription drugs, housing, child care, higher education or put away funds for retirement. They are also trying hard to maintain their family life amidst irregular work scheduling patterns."

Today, the two richest people in our country own more wealth than the bottom 40 percent. The top 1% own more wealth than the bottom 92%.

During the pandemic, when thousands of essential workers died doing their jobs, some 700 billionaires in America became more than \$2 trillion richer. As the rich get richer, corporate profits are soaring and the CEOs of major corporations are earning outrageous compensation packages.

Unbelievably, they now make over 350 times as much as their average employees as they receive large salaries, stock options, "golden parachutes" and a wide range of perks.

In the midst of this growing inequality, workers throughout the country are fighting back. As corporate profits skyrocket and top corporate executive receive outlandish pay, these workers are demanding their fair share. They want decent wages, benefits and working conditions. They want to be treated with respect.

Last year, Kellogg's made over \$1.4 billion in profits. It paid its CEO, Steven Cahillane, nearly \$12 million in total compensation, a significant increase over recent years.

At the Kellogg's plant in Battle Creek, Michigan for example, when the pandemic began many employees worked more than 50 days in a row – often 12-hour days.

The two-month long strike by BCTGM International Union workers stressed better wages and an end to a grossly destructive "two-tier" system which provides newer workers substantially lower wages and benefits than long-term employees.

Kellogg's management terminated the health care benefits for striking workers, leaving many of them with no health insurance at all before Christmas. The company also began hiring permanent replacement employees in positions vacated by striking workers.

They also threatened to outsource 275 jobs from Michigan to Mexico where new workers are paid just 97 cents an hour in an attempt to break the union.

The workers' struggle against Kellogg's included 1,400 employees on strike in Michigan, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, and Nebraska.

Bernie said, "I am proud to join the striking Kellogg's workers in their fight for justice and dignity." Pointing out how big business looks out for their managers more than their workers. He called on Kellogg's to be fair to the workers who have sacrificed to keep the company open during the worst pandemic of our lifetime. "Like other large corporations, they must understand that it cannot have it all, their workers deserve a fair shake."

El senador Bernie Sanders reunió a los trabajadores y alentó a Kellogg's a negociar un acuerdo justo y dejar de participar en las actividades antisindicales que se llevan a cabo allí en diciembre. Los trabajadores sindicalizados de Kellogg's obtuvieron un acuerdo después de una huelga de 77 días. A \$ 1.10 centavos por hora para todos los empleados, entre muchas otras concesiones, terminó la huelga.

Según el senador Bernie Sanders, la desigualdad de ingresos y riqueza de Estados Unidos está en su nivel más alto en 100 años. "Después de ajustar por inflación, el trabajador promedio en Estados Unidos está ganando \$ 40 dólares por semana menos hoy que hace 48 años. El resultado: millones de familias de clase trabajadora están luchando para pagar la atención médica, los medicamentos recetados, la vivienda, el cuidado de los niños, la educación superior o los fondos destinados a la jubilación. También están esforzándose por mantener su vida familiar en medio de patrones irregulares de programación de trabajo".

Hoy, las dos personas más ricas de nuestro país poseen más riqueza que el 40 por ciento inferior. El 1% superior posee más riqueza que el 92% inferior.

Durante la pandemia, cuando miles de trabajadores esenciales murieron haciendo su trabajo, unos 700 multimillonarios en Estados Unidos se hicieron más de \$ 2 billones más ricos. A medida que los ricos se hacen más ricos, las ganancias corporativas se disparan y los directores ejecutivos de las principales corporaciones están ganando paquetes de compensación escandalosos.

SOCIAL MEDIA CAMPAIGNS ENCOURAGED BOYCOTT OF KELLOGG'S AND HELPED AGREEMENT

The Kellogg Co. actively sought the hiring of new employees to replace the roughly 1,400 striking workers from plants that make the company's well-known brands of cereal. That strategy led to Social Media viral tweets and posts condemning the company and raised the ire of many union supporting Americans who began informal boycotts across the country. Social media is full of posts encouraging consumers to stop buying Kellogg's Cereals and products even though a settlement has been reached. The power of social media must not be overlooked by corporations or unions in America as social influence has again proven to be an effective tool for advancing important issues.

El año pasado, Kellogg's obtuvo más de \$ 1.4 mil millones en ganancias. Le pagó a su CEO, Steven Cahillane, casi \$ 12 millones en compensación total, un aumento significativo en los últimos años.

En la planta de Kellogg's en Battle Creek, Michigan, por ejemplo, cuando comenzó la pandemia, muchos empleados trabajaban más de 50 días seguidos, a menudo jornadas de 12 horas.

La huelga de dos meses de los trabajadores de BCTGM International Union hizo hincapié en mejores salarios y el fin de un sistema "de dos niveles" extremadamente destructivo que proporciona a los trabajadores más nuevos salarios y beneficios sustancialmente más bajos que los empleados a largo plazo.

La gerencia de Kellogg's canceló los beneficios de atención médica para los trabajadores en huelga, dejando a muchos de ellos sin seguro médico antes de Navidad. La compañía también comenzó a contratar empleados de reemplazo permanente en los puestos vacantes por los trabajadores en huelga.

También amenazaron con subcontratar 275 puestos de trabajo de Michigan a México, donde a los nuevos trabajadores se les paga solo 97 centavos la hora en un intento de romper el sindicato.

Kellogg Co. buscó activamente la contratación de nuevos empleados para reemplazar a los aproximadamente 1.400 trabajadores en huelga de las plantas que fabrican las conocidas marcas de cereales de la empresa. Esta estrategia generó tweets y publicaciones virales en las redes sociales que condenaban a la empresa y provocó la ira de muchos estadounidenses que apoyaban a los sindicatos y que iniciaron boicots informales en todo el país. Las redes sociales están llenas de publicaciones que animan a los consumidores a dejar de comprar cereales y productos Kellogg's a pesar de que se ha llegado a un acuerdo. El poder de las redes sociales no debe ser pasado por alto por las corporaciones o sindicatos en Estados Unidos, ya que la influencia social ha demostrado una vez más ser una herramienta eficaz para promover cuestiones importantes.

La lucha de los trabajadores contra Kellogg's incluyó a 1.400 empleados en huelga en Michigan, Pensilvania, Tennessee y Nebraska.

Bernie dijo: "Estoy orgulloso de unirme a los trabajadores de Kellogg's en huelga en su lucha por la justicia y la dignidad". Pfizer Covid pills may be risky with other medications

As the omicron surge pummels a pandemic-weary nation, the first antiviral pills for Covid-19 promise desperately needed protection for people at risk of severe disease. However, many people prescribed Pfizer's or Merck's new medications will require careful monitoring by doctors and pharmacists, and the antivirals may not be safe for everyone, experts caution.

The Food and Drug Administration authorized Pfizer's Paxlovid for mild to moderate Covid in people as young as 12 who have underlying conditions that raise the risk of hospitalization and death from the coronavirus, such as heart disease or diabetes.

However, one of the two drugs in the antiviral cocktail could cause severe or life-threatening interactions with widely used medications, including statins, blood thinners and some antidepressants. And the FDA does not recommend Paxlovid for people with severe kidney or liver disease.

Cuba Advances Research on Nasal Vaccine Against COVID-19



Cuban scientists are advancing research on a nasal vaccine against COVID-19, Eduardo Martínez, president of the state-owned biotechnology and pharmaceutical industries group BioCubaFarma.

"We think it may help prevent transmission of #SARS-CoV2 and provide a certain level of immunity," the scientist added.

Martínez assured that the vaccine candidate Mambisa "has demonstrated a high mucosal immune response against SARS-CoV-2 in clinical studies. It could be very effective against transmission."

Cuba has three homegrown vaccines against COVID-19 (Abdala, Soberana-02 and Soberana Plus), which it has used to mass immunize the 11.2 million Cubans.



An unlikely pairing — as both have often been pitted against each other throughout their career — Guzmán and Rubio will "face off in a once-in-a-lifetime run of shows" across the U.S. with a trek that kicks off April 15 in Orlando and wraps up May 22 in Los Angeles. With no major promoting company attached to the tour, the 23-date stint will be produced by the artists themselves.

The chart-topping artists are set to "perform on the same stage to settle the score, promising an electrifying, heart-stopping experience," according to a press release. "It's time to get back to concerts, break molds and reset with music. Going back to concerts, is going back to life," Rubio added. "This is going to be a dangerous summer," Guzmán teased.

Guzmán, known to her fans as "La Reina de Corazones (Queen of Hearts)," has overall grossed a total of \$11.6 million and has sold 265,000 tickets across 69 shows, according

to figures reported to Billboard Boxscore. Meanwhile, Rubio, a.k.a. "La Chica Dorada (Golden Girl)," has sold 91,000 tickets sold across 36 shows grossing \$3.4 million.


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COVID-19 Vaccine Guidance for Pregnancy and Breastfeeding



When COVID-19 vaccines first became available, health experts did not initially recommend that pregnant individuals receive the vaccine out of an abundance of caution – and left it up to the individuals to make that decision with their health care provider.

As more information became available, that advice has changed. The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, as well as the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, and the Society for Maternal Fetal Medicine now recommend that individuals who are pregnant, breastfeeding, trying to get pregnant or may be pregnant in the future get vaccinated against COVID-19, and receive a booster dose if needed.

This is because there's evidence that people who are pregnant or who were recently pregnant are more likely to get severely sick from COVID-19 – compared to people who are not pregnant; and that people who have COVID during pregnancy are at an increased risk of pregnancy complications.

None of the COVID-19 vaccines can cause anyone to be infected. They program your immune system to respond to the virus should you encounter it in the future.

IF YOU'RE PREGNANT:

- The CDC recommends vaccination against COVID.
- The CDC recommends a booster shot against COVID.
- If you have a fever after being vaccinated, it's important to take acetaminophen as fevers during pregnancy have been associated with adverse pregnancy outcomes.
- Vaccination during pregnancy might help protect the fetus against COVID-19. Research has found antibodies in umbilical cord blood after a pregnant person received a mRNA COVID vaccine.
- Talk to your health care provider if you have questions.

IF YOU'RE BREASTFEEDING:

- Recent reports shown individuals who are breastfeeding after having received an mRNA COVID vaccine have antibodies in their breastmilk. More research is needed to see what level of protection a baby receives from these antibodies.

There's a growing body of evidence that the benefits of receiving a COVID-19 vaccine during pregnancy greatly outweigh any known or potential risks.



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Americans More Comfortable Dining Out Again!

The restaurant industry, like many others, was hit hard when states across the country first went into lockdowns, and businesses had to rely solely on takeout and delivery to stay afloat. Restaurants have since been able to reopen their dining rooms to various degrees, and though it may take time for the industry to fully recover, Americans are missing the pre-pandemic dining experience. Since Morning Consult began tracking comfort levels in spring 2020, Americans have consistently said the activity they are more comfortable with is dining out.

- Americans' Comfort With Dining Out Ticks Up: 66% of U.S. adults said they feel comfortable going out to eat at a restaurant as of a Dec. 16-19 survey, up 2 percentage points from last week, when the comfort level hit the lowest point since September.

- Comfort With Indoor Dining Sees Little Change Despite Omicron: 65% of Americans said they feel comfortable going to an indoor restaurant, a 1-point uptick from last week. Respondents' comfort level has ranged between 62% and 67% since the end of September, despite the emergence of the omicron variant in late November. The public's comfort with dining outdoors was 74% as of the latest poll, an increase of 2 points from last week.

When will things return to normal and what will our new normal look like? It's a question that business, economic and government leaders are grappling with as more and more Americans receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

To help answer this complicated question, Morning Consult is tracking how consumer attitudes are shifting across a wide range of categories, from travel to entertainment to dining, to gain greater insight into not only when consumers will be ready to return to their normal activities, but how their habits will be forever changed. We'll be updating these pages every week with new data and analyses.

La industria de los restaurantes, como muchas otras, se vio muy afectada cuando los estados de todo el país se bloquearon por primera vez y las empresas tuvieron que depender únicamente de la comida para llevar y la entrega a domicilio para mantenerse a flote. Desde entonces, los restaurantes han podido reabrir sus comedores en varios grados y, aunque la industria puede tardar un tiempo en recuperarse por completo, los estadounidenses se están perdiendo la experiencia gastronómica anterior a la pandemia. Desde que Morning Consult comenzó a rastrear los niveles de comodidad en la primavera de 2020, los estadounidenses siempre han dicho que la actividad con la que se sienten más cómodos es salir a cenar.

- La comodidad de los estadounidenses al salir a cenar aumenta: el 66% de los adultos estadounidenses dijeron que se sentían cómodos saliendo a comer a un restaurante según una encuesta del 16 al 19 de diciembre, 2 puntos porcentuales más que la semana pasada, cuando el nivel de comodidad alcanzó el punto más bajo desde septiembre.

- La comodidad con la comida en el interior ve pocos cambios a pesar de Omicron: el 65% de los estadounidenses dijeron que se sienten cómodos yendo a un restaurante interior, un aumento de 1 punto con respecto a la semana pasada. El nivel de comodidad de los encuestados ha oscilado entre el 62% y el 67% desde finales de septiembre, a pesar de la aparición de la variante omicron a finales de noviembre. La comodidad del público con cenar al aire libre fue del 74% según la última encuesta, un aumento de 2 puntos con respecto a la semana pasada.

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
