



THE END OF AN ERA

A tribute to María Martin by Julio Cesar Guerrero, MSW, MA

I met María Martin in the late 1970's when we were part of a handful of Chicano radio activists. In the early 1980's while in the Bay Area, we regularly collaborated on projects and news stories. Like many pioneers, she was a visionary who created a space for Raza and women through programming and mentorship in professional field that rarely accepted minorities. With her characteristic smile, good nature and professionalism, she graciously penetrated both, English and Spanish markets covering an ample array of issues and personalities that chronicled who we are as people in the United States.

She was a founder of KBBF in Santa Rosa, California the first bi-lingual radio station in America as well as the founder of NPR's Latino USA based in Austin Texas, and the GraciasVida Center for Media based in Antigua Guatemala, among others.

She was a founder and leader in both public and independent media, and media education in Spanish and English-- primarily covering issues related to LatinX people in the U.S. and Latin America as well as indigenous people.

For the last ten years, the Center has worked to improve the skills and working situation for rural and indigenous journalists in Guatemala, Bolivia, and Nicaragua, as well as to improve the coverage of Central America on U.S. public radio.

Martin was a tireless reporter and creative producer, dedicated to journalism at its highest level and its broadest reach. She taught journalism in university classrooms, and in small towns from West Virginia to Guatemala, Kyrgyzstan, and in Bolivia, where she literally went village to village teaching people how to report and publish about their conditions, passions and concerns. "María" was a leader in both news coverage and culture, as well as religion. In her book, "Crossing Bridges: A Journalist's Heart in Latin America", Martin tells her story overcoming the many obstacles of racism and sexism, forging a path for the next generation of independent, and LatinX journalists, especially women. She will be terribly missed by her huge network of fans and friends, on both sides of the border and around the world. For the past 20 years she made her home in her beloved Antigua, Guatemala with regular trips to Austin and San Antonio, Texas where she recently became affiliated with "The Esperanza, Peace and Justice Center."

María Martin was the recipient of Fulbrights and several Knight Fellowships, including the John S. Knight Professional Journalism Fellowship at Stanford University, and the Reagan-Fascell Democracy Fellowship awarded by the National Endowment for Democracy. Martin has won over two dozen awards for her work covering Latino issues and Latin America. She was especially proud of her recent documentary series, Después de las Guerras: Central America After the Wars. She holds a Master's degree in journalism from the Ohio State University. In September of 2015, Martin was inducted into the Hall of Fame of the National Association of Hispanic Journalists.

On Saturday December 2nd., Sister María Martin left this world after a series of medical complications. We are profoundly grateful to have crossed paths with such a media giant and most beautiful human being. Descansa en paz mi hermana.

Con su sonrisa característica, buen carácter y profesionalismo, penetró gentilmente en los mercados inglés y español cubriendo una amplia gama de temas y personalidades que narraron quiénes somos como personas en los Estados Unidos. Fundadora de KBBF en Santa Rosa, California, la primera estación de radio bilingüe en Estados Unidos, así como fundadora de Latino USA de NPR con sede en Austin, Texas, y del GraciasVida Center for Media con sede en Antigua Guatemala, entre otros. Fue fundadora y líder de medios públicos e independientes, y de educación mediática en español e inglés, cubriendo principalmente temas relacionados con los latinos en los EE. UU. y América Latina, así como con los pueblos indígenas.

María Martin recibió becas Fulbrights y varias becas Knight, incluida la beca de periodismo profesional John S. Knight en la Universidad de Stanford y la beca para la democracia Reagan-Fascell otorgada por el National Endowment for Democracy. Martin ha ganado más de dos docenas de premios por su trabajo que cubre temas latinos y América Latina. Estaba especialmente orgullosa de su reciente serie documental, Después de las Guerras: Centroamérica Después de las Guerras. Tiene una maestría en periodismo de la Universidad Estatal de Ohio. En septiembre de 2015, Martin fue incluida en el Salón de la Fama de la Asociación Nacional de Periodistas Hispanos.

El sábado 2 de diciembre, Sor María Martín dejó este mundo. Estamos profundamente agradecidos de habernos cruzado en nuestro camino con un gigante mediático y un ser humano tan hermoso.

La Corrupción en la Legislatura de Puerto Rico: El Caso de María Milagros "Tata" Charbonier y Orlando Montes Rivera

Corruption in the Puerto Rico Legislature: The Case of María Milagros "Tata" Charbonier and Orlando Montes Rivera

actualmente enfrentan un proceso judicial en el tribunal federal por cargos que van desde conspiración hasta lavado de dinero.

La acusación sostiene que Charbonier y Montes Rivera participaron en una serie de delitos, incluyendo conspiración, robo, soborno y comisiones ilegales relacionadas con programas que reciben fondos federales. Además, se les imputa fraude electrónico por servicios honestos, así como dos cargos de lavado de dinero. Un cargo adicional de obstrucción a la justicia pesa sobre Charbonier por la destrucción de datos en su teléfono celular.

Uno de los aspectos más reveladores de la investigación es la presunta inflación del salario de Frances Acevedo Ceballos, directora de la oficina legislativa de Tata Charbonier. Se alega que Charbonier infló el salario de Ceballos para que esta devolviera a la familia entre \$1,000 a \$1,500 mensuales. Bajo este esquema, la exlegisladora habría recibido aproximadamente \$100,000 desde septiembre de 2017 hasta el verano de 2020.

Este caso no solo destapa la corrupción individual, sino que arroja luz sobre posibles prácticas sistémicas dentro de la legislatura de Puerto Rico. En este contexto, es imperativo que las autoridades pertinentes, incluyendo la contralora de Puerto Rico, el secretario de Hacienda y otras agencias federales y estatales, realicen investigaciones exhaustivas que abarquen la última década.

Es crucial implementar medidas preventivas para salvaguardar la integridad del sistema. Proponemos la creación de un programa de inteligencia artificial que monitoree a diario y detecte de manera proactiva cualquier aumento inusual en los salarios de los empleados gubernamentales. Este enfoque tecnológico podría contribuir a prevenir prácticas corruptas y garantizar la transparencia en el manejo de los fondos públicos.

Además, se insta a una investigación integral de todos los legisladores y sus empleados para identificar posibles irregularidades y limpiar el nombre de aquellos que han actuado de manera ética. Es hora de restablecer la confianza en las instituciones gubernamentales mediante la aplicación rigurosa de la ley y la rendición de cuentas.

En última instancia, se propone aumentar las penas por corrupción, especialmente cuando se trata de robo contra el gobierno de Puerto Rico. Introducir agravantes por delito grave podría disuadir a aquellos tentados por la corrupción y enviar un mensaje claro de que la sociedad no tolerará la malversación de fondos públicos.

Puerto Rico merece un gobierno transparente, eficiente y libre de corrupción. La revelación de casos como el de la ex representante del PNP - María Milagros "Tata" Charbonier subraya la urgencia de implementar medidas que fortalezcan la integridad de nuestras instituciones

y restauren la confianza perdida en el servicio público.



Puerto Rico, a land of charm and diversity, has been shaken by a scandal that exposes deep-rooted corruption within its legislature. At the epicenter of this crisis is former PNP representative María Milagros "Tata" Charbonier and her husband, Orlando Montes Rivera, who are currently facing legal proceedings in federal court on charges ranging from conspiracy to money laundering.

The accusation alleges that the ex-legislator Charbonier and Montes Rivera engaged in a series of crimes, including conspiracy, theft, bribery, and illegal commissions related to programs receiving federal funds. Additionally, they are charged with electronic fraud for honest services, as well as two counts of money laundering. An additional charge of obstruction of justice hangs over Charbonier for the destruction of data on her cell phone.

One of the most revealing aspects of the investigation is the alleged inflation of the salary of Frances Acevedo Ceballos, director of Tata Charbonier's legislative office. It is claimed that Charbonier inflated Ceballos's salary so that she would return between \$1,000 to \$1,500 monthly to the family. Under this scheme, the former legislator would have received approximately \$100,000 from September 2017 to the summer of 2020.

This case not only exposes individual corruption but also sheds light on possible systemic practices within the Puerto Rico Legislature. In this context, it is imperative that relevant authorities, including the Puerto Rico comptroller, the Secretary of Treasury, and other federal and state agencies, conduct thorough investigations spanning the past decade.

It is crucial to implement preventive measures to safeguard the integrity of the system. We propose the creation of an artificial intelligence program that monitors and proactively detects any unusual increase in government employee salaries on a daily basis. This technological approach could contribute to preventing corrupt practices and ensuring transparency in the handling of public funds.

Furthermore, a comprehensive investigation of all legislators and their staff is urged to identify possible irregularities and clear the names of those who have acted ethically. It is time to restore trust in government institutions through rigorous law enforcement and accountability.

Ultimately, there is a proposal to increase penalties for corruption, especially when it involves theft against the government of Puerto Rico. Introducing aggravating factors for serious offenses could deter those tempted by corruption and send a clear message that society will not tolerate the misappropriation of public funds.

Puerto Rico deserves a transparent, efficient, and corruption-free government. The revelation of cases like that of former PNP representative María Milagros "Tata" Charbonier underscores the urgency of implementing measures that strengthen the integrity of our institutions and restore lost trust in public service.

Michigan Reconnect Short-Term Training Program Launches to Provide Michiganders an Additional Path to In-Demand Careers



Michigan students 21 and older to receive up to \$1,500 to attend eligible career training program

The Michigan Department of Lifelong Education, Advancement, and Potential (MiLEAP) announced the launch of the Michigan Reconnect Short-Term Training Program, a new career training scholarship that saves students \$1,500 as they gain skills needed to prepare for in-demand jobs.

The Reconnect Short-Term Training Program scholarship is backed by a \$6 million investment through the state budget. Under the program, Michiganders age 21 and older who don't yet have a college degree are eligible to receive up to \$1,500 to attend an eligible career training program in Michigan.

"Every Michigander deserves the opportunity to pursue a degree or certificate to land a good-paying, in-demand job without breaking the bank," said Governor Gretchen Whitmer. "The Michigan Reconnect Short-Term Training Program will lower costs by offering students up to \$1,500 as they pursue a career in health care, technology, manufacturing, and so much more. Together, we will grow our economy by delivering on our promise to ensure every Michigander can 'make it' in Michigan."

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Michigan Reconnect Short-Term Training Program, applicants must:

- Be at least 21 years of age prior to submitting the application.
- Be a Michigan resident for at least the immediately preceding year.
- Have graduated from high school with a diploma or a certificate of completion or achieved a high school equivalency certificate and provide a copy to their training provider.

- Have not yet earned an associate or bachelor's degree.

To apply, interested students must complete an online application at Michigan.gov/Reconnect. To qualify, students must submit an application by Dec. 15, 2024, and begin their career training program prior to Dec. 31, 2024.

- *Haberse graduado de la escuela secundaria con un diploma o certificado de finalización o haber obtenido un certificado de equivalencia de escuela secundaria y proporcionar una copia a su proveedor de capacitación.*
- *Aún no haber obtenido un título de asociado o de licenciatura.*

Para postularse, los estudiantes interesados deben completar una solicitud en línea en Michigan.gov/Reconnect. Para calificar, los estudiantes deben enviar una solicitud antes del 15 de diciembre de 2024 y comenzar su programa de capacitación profesional antes del 31 de diciembre de 2024.

Deliberate Deception, Never Trust a Gringo

Those who read and learn beyond enough to survive are not ordinary people. Tragically most Mexican Americans will never know their own language or history. Mostly, because the government deliberately lied, minimized and omitted relevant information during our developmental years. Those raised before computers were misled and often infected with a sense inferiority by their teachers. However, ignorance is not irreversible.

Today as an educated, traveled man, having attended multiple universities I am staggered at the malice these acts required. As a counselor and grass roots organizer who met Cesar Chavez, Dolores Huerta and Vicente Fox, president of Mexico, I am floored by the bigotry. Politicians and rich industrialists never meant for us to get an education. The Rockefellers, Carnegies, Fords, Guggenheims, Morgan's and Vanderbilts never valued our contributions. Outside of cheap labor and cannon fodder during war we were not seen as useful, nor of much value. Trump reminded us the majority populations sees as a burden. My journey through the halls of academia exposed horrible realities. Especially while at Tuloso-Midway high school in Corpus Christi Texas. As an example, I'll convey an experience with a Chicano school teacher I met while in the military. We became friends because we supported the Chicano movement of the 1970s during the Vietnam war. Rufino was a college graduate, native of Arizona and a teacher before being drafted. He could have become an officer but preferred to only serve two years as an enlisted man. I envied Rufino, assuming he was well educated. I've discovered he was not, as the American educational system is rigged to minimize or omit Mexican American contributions. I was disappointed Rufino, a college graduate did not know Mexico declared war on Germany after five Mexican oil tankers were sunk by German U-Boats in 1942. This information was omitted from our history books. Mexico sent the 201 Fighter Squadron to the Philippine Islands. Mexican President Manuel Avila Camacho declared war on Germany, Italy and Japan on May 28, 1942.

The fighter squadron known as the Aztec Eagles flew 96 missions fighting alongside expeditionary units in support of the allies. The Aztec Eagles were Mexico's only military unit to ever engage in combat outside the country's national borders. In the years after World War II, five of the pilots who began their flying careers in Escuadra 201 reached the rank of general in the Mexican Air Force. Aside from helping to fight the war, thousands of Mexican nationals crossed the border to work in agriculture as part of the Bracero Program, which gringo teachers emphasized. Not surprisingly, we also were repeatedly told all the defenders at the Alamo in 1836 were butchered by bloodthirsty, cowardly Mexicans who arrived to deny Americans their freedom. No one mentioned Anglo settlers swore an oath, vowed to adopt Catholicism and free their slaves, of which they did none.

We were also never told native Tejanos fought also alongside so-called Anglo heroes inside the Alamo against Santa Ana. Tejanos served with General Houston at the Battle of San Jacinto and Captain Juan Seguin who served in the Texas senate and reelected mayor in 1840. For such heroic men to be deliberately omitted brings shame upon all teachers who omitted their sacrifices because of xenophobia and bigotry. Yet, they are required to entrust our children to teachers and the Anglo view of history. There is tremendous cause for concern amongst XYZ Mexican-Americans who believe the myth of a post-racist's society. Mexican Americans who deny their ethnicity and identify as white like many of my relatives, because their ashamed of their Mexican roots, culture and heritage need only open a dozen books and become enlightened. Auto-hatred as displayed by Justice Clarence Thomas and ex-Attorney General Alberto R. Gonzalez based on racial identity is a common cause of suicide, dysphoria and social pathology.

Principalmente porque el gobierno mintió, minimizó y omitió deliberadamente información relevante durante nuestros años de desarrollo. Aquellos que crecieron antes de las computadoras fueron engañados y a menudo infectados por un sentimiento de inferioridad por parte de sus maestros. Sin embargo, la ignorancia no es irreversible.

Hoy, como hombre educado y viajero, que ha asistido a varias universidades, estoy asombrado por la malicia que requirieron estos actos. Como consejero y organizador de base que conocí a César Chávez, Dolores Huerta y Vicente Fox, presidente de México, estoy anonadado por la intolerancia. Los políticos y los industriales ricos nunca quisieron que recibiéramos una educación. Los Rockefeller, Carnegie, Ford, Guggenheim, Morgan y Vanderbilt nunca valoraron nuestras contribuciones. Aparte de la mano de obra barata y la carne de cañón durante la guerra, no se nos consideraba útiles ni de mucho valor. Trump nos recordó que la mayoría de la población lo ve como una carga. Mi viaje por los pasillos del mundo académico expuso realidades horribles. Especialmente mientras estaba en la escuela secundaria Tuloso-Midway en Corpus Christi, Texas. Como ejemplo, transmitiré una experiencia con un maestro de escuela chicano que conocí mientras estaba en el ejército. Rufino era un graduado universitario, nativo de Arizona y profesor antes de ser reclutado. Envidiaba a Rufino, viendo que tuviera una buena educación. Descubrí que no lo era, ya que el sistema educativo estadounidense está manipulado para minimizar u omitir las contribuciones mexicano-estadounidenses. Rufino, un graduado universitario, no sabía que México declaró la guerra a Alemania después de que cinco petroleros mexicanos fueran hundidos por submarinos alemanes en 1942. Esta información se omitió en nuestros libros de historia. México envió el Escuadrón de Cazas 201 a las Islas Filipinas. El presidente mexicano Manuel Ávila Camacho declaró la guerra a Alemania, Italia y Japón el 28 de mayo de 1942.

Tampoco nos dijeron que los nativos tejanos también lucharon junto a los llamados héroes anglosajones dentro del Álamo contra Santa Ana. Hay tremendos motivos de preocupación entre los mexicano-estadounidenses de XYZ que creen en el mito de una sociedad posracista. Los mexicano-estadounidenses que niegan su origen étnico y se identifican como blancos como muchos de mis parientes, porque se avergüenzan de sus raíces, cultura y herencia mexicanas, sólo necesitan abrir una docena de libros e iluminarse.

COVID is on the rise again and the CDC have devised a new way to track whether rates are on the rise - with 23 states currently suffering "very high" viral activity.

Since Thanksgiving, COVID numbers have risen, with a 3.1 percent increase in hospital admissions since December 9. And the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has used data to pinpoint the states which are currently worst affected by the latest COVID rise and categorize them into groups. Unfortunately, "very high" is the largest category with 23 states included.

According to CDC data, these states include: Arkansas, Delaware, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Jersey, North Carolina, Ohio, South Carolina, South Dakota, Vermont, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.



¡Desconecta para conectarte! / Disconnect to connect!

Recientemente, una amiga me compartió que su hija, una preadolescente había pasado por un proceso similar a romper con una adicción. Cabe decir que la palabra adicción tiene una connotación pesada, y ante eso utilizaré su sinónimo necesidad. Al indagar más sobre su revelación, ella mencionó que, como parte de un proceso disciplinario, le quitó el celular a su hija durante un tiempo. Después de unos días, su maternal proceso de observación la llevó a identificar, en las acciones de la joven, las etapas de la desintoxicación tecnológica, también conocida como détox digital.



Al principio las actitudes de la adolescente se pasearon entre la negación, la ansiedad y el aislamiento por la ausencia de su dispositivo. Poco tiempo después, sus conductas se transformaron positivamente. Regresaron las actividades creativas, retomó sus antiguos pasatiempos, se reintegró a las reuniones familiares e incluso comenzó a planear proyectos de emprendimiento para el futuro. Ante tal historia, me di a la tarea de investigar sobre los efectos del apego de los adolescentes a los recursos tecnológicos.

¿Qué es la necesidad tecnológica? La urgencia o adicción tecnológica ocurre al no poder acceder a las redes sociales y a las plataformas de entretenimiento en línea. De acuerdo con la psicóloga Marta Thomen, los síntomas de la necesidad tecnológica son similares a otras conductas de dependencia y pueden incluir ansiedad, irritabilidad y depresión. También causan desesperación, agotamiento

visual y estrés físico y mental. Otro aspecto perjudicial para los adolescentes es que la exposición a la luz azul de las pantallas interfiere con el sueño y hace que sea más difícil conciliar un buen descanso.

Sin embargo, la idea no es censurar la tecnología, pues a causa de la pandemia más reciente fue una alternativa para dar continuidad a procesos necesarios como la telemedicina y la enseñanza, entre muchos otros. Lo ideal es encontrar el equilibrio entre la vida cotidiana sana y saludable, llena de experiencias y la utilización prudente de los recursos tecnológicos.

Una desintoxicación digital consistente puede comenzar con incluir la desconexión como rutina, proponiendo un día de la semana sin tecnología y estableciendo una hora para guardar los dispositivos. Planificando actividades al aire libre para conectarse mejor con el mundo real y con las personas que les rodean. Es importante dar un buen ejemplo, pues resulta difícil motivar a los adolescentes a que limiten el uso de la tecnología si en el hogar los adultos están constantemente en sus dispositivos. Por último, es necesario fomentar el diálogo familiar y reflexionar acerca de que el consumo desmedido de contenidos "entretenedores" realmente es un intercambio de tiempo y salud.

Recently, a friend shared with me that her daughter, a preteen, had gone through a process like breaking an addiction. It should be said that the word addiction has a heavy connotation, and in view of that I will use its synonym need. When asked more about her revelation, she mentioned that, as part of a disciplinary process, she took her daughter's cell phone away for a while. After a few days, her maternal observation process led her to identify, in the young woman's actions, the stages of technological detoxification, also known as digital detox.

At first, the teenager's attitudes ranged from denial, anxiety, and isolation due to the absence of her device. A short time later, her behavior was positively transformed. Creative activities returned, he resumed his old hobbies, rejoined family gatherings, and even began planning entrepreneurship projects for the future. Faced with such a story, I took on the task of researching the effects of adolescents' attachment to technological resources.

What is technological need? Technological urgency or addiction occurs from not being able to access social media and online entertainment platforms. According to psychologist Marta Thomen, the symptoms of technological neediness are like other dependency behaviours and can include anxiety, irritability, and depression. They also cause despair, visual exhaustion, and physical and mental stress. Another detrimental aspect for teens is that exposure to blue light from screens interferes with sleep and makes it harder to get a good night's sleep.

However, the idea is not to censor technology, because due to the most recent pandemic it was an alternative to give continuity to necessary processes such as telemedicine and teaching, among many others. The ideal is to find the balance between a healthy and healthy daily life, full of experiences and the prudent use of technological resources.

A consistent digital detox can start with including unplugging as a routine, proposing a tech-free day of the week, and setting a time to put devices away. Planning outdoor activities to better connect with the real world and the people around them. It's important to set a good example, because it's hard to motivate teens to limit their use of technology if adults are constantly on their devices at home. Finally, it is necessary to encourage family dialogue and reflect on the fact that the excessive consumption of "entertaining" content is really an exchange of time and health.

Mario Vargas Llosa in Puerto Rico

El pasado 10 de noviembre, el ganador del Premio Nobel de Literatura en 2010, Mario Vargas Llosa dictó un mensaje acerca de la importancia de defender y valorar la libertad. Este evento fue un regalo a la comunidad como parte de la celebración del décimo aniversario del Centro de Renovación Económica, Crecimiento y Excelencia mejor conocido como CRECE, fundado por el exgobernador de Puerto Rico, Luis Fortuño. En su mensaje, el autor fue relatando su recorrido desde sus iniciales convicciones comunistas y cómo éstas, a causa de las experiencias de injusticia, se transformaron en liberalistas.

En el evento, explicó el laureado escritor peruano, que para él la palabra liberalismo se refiere a la defensa del individuo frente al poder del Estado y cómo debe elevarse la igualdad como persona ante la ley. Asimismo, el liberalismo incluye el conjunto de principios que protegen a las personas, así como su vida, libertad y propiedad frente a cualquier abuso.

La trayectoria literaria de Vargas Llosa ha recibido importantes reconocimientos. Entre estos, el Premio Leopoldo Alas dado en 1959, el Premio Biblioteca Breve otorgado en 1962, Premio Rómulo Gallego de 1967 y el Premio Príncipe de Asturias de las Letras en 1986. En 1993, Vargas Llosa también recibió el Premio Planeta. En 1994 ganó el Premio Cervantes, el reconocimiento literario más importante del mundo hispano, y en 2010 fue galardonado con el Premio Nobel de Literatura por su compromiso con la libertad y la democracia.

En la proximidad del año 2024, la literatura y experiencia de este extraordinario escritor ofrece un caudal de conocimiento en beneficio de las futuras generaciones. Así éstas podrán actuar como los defensores de la libertad y en favor del desarrollo equitativo de los países. Inspirados en la reflexión de que es indispensable seguir batallando en favor de las ideas de la libertad, convencidos de que ellas traerán el progreso a los pueblos.

On November 10, the winner of the 2010 Nobel Prize in Literature, Mario Vargas Llosa, delivered an eloquent message in Puerto Rico about the importance of defending and valuing freedom. This event was a gift to the community as part of the celebration of the tenth anniversary of the Center for Economic Renewal, Growth and Excellence better known as CRECE, founded by the former governor of Puerto Rico, Luis Fortuño. In his message, the author recounted his journey from his initial communist convictions and how, because of the experiences of injustice, they were transformed into liberalists.

At the event, the award-winning Peruvian writer explained that for him the word liberalism refers to the defense of the individual against the power of the State and how equality as a person before the law should be raised. Likewise, liberalism includes the set of principles that protect people, as well as their life, liberty, and property from abuse.



Vargas Llosa's literary career has received important recognitions. Among these, the Leopoldo Alas Prize awarded in 1959, the Biblioteca Breve Prize awarded in 1962, the Rómulo Gallego Prize in 1967 and the Prince of Asturias Award for Literature in 1986. In 1993, Vargas Llosa also received the Planeta Prize. In 1994 he won the Cervantes Prize, the most important literary award in the Hispanic world, and in 2010 he was awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature for his commitment to freedom and democracy.

As the year 2024 approaches, the literature and experience of this extraordinary writer offers a wealth of knowledge for the benefit of future generations. In this way, they will be able to act as defenders of freedom and in favor of the equitable development of countries. Inspired by the reflection that it is essential to continue fighting in favor of the ideas of freedom, convinced that they will bring progress to the peoples.



In 2021, PBR entered a new partnership with Pluto TV bringing the wild west into the streaming frontier. PBR RIDEPASS has streamed exclusively on Pluto TV, featuring hundreds of hours of live professional bull riding, rodeo, and other Western sporting events. This includes PBR's Unleash the Beast and the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour.

More than eight hundred bull riders from around the world, including the United States, Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico hold PBR memberships.

The Whisky Velocity Tour is the primary and most important qualifying series for forty bull riders to earn valuable points needed to qualify for a spot in the coveted Unleash the Beast Tour, and ultimately the PBR World Finals. The finals will take place in Arlington, Texas May 18 & 19, with a preshow performance the night before with Kid Rock at Kid Rock's Rock N Rodeo.

Last year's World Champion, Rafael Jose de Brito, made PBR history when he became the first rider ever to win the world title and Rookie of the Year honors in the same season. The 31-year-old Brazilian came to America in 2022 and came from behind in the standings to win the World Finals event and 2023 PBR World Championship.

But the cowboys are not the only athletes on this tour competing for cash and a championship. There are also the animal athletes. With names like Bodacious, Bushwacker, Smooth Operator and Code Blue, the bulls are also vying for the title of Yeti PBR World Champion Bull. That title is currently held by Ridin' Solo, who also held the 2022 title. The average PBR bull weighs between 1,600 and 1,800 pounds

The PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour rolls into the VanAndel Arena with two shows. January 19 at 7:00 p.m. and January 20, at 8:00 p.m. Tickets are still available through Ticketmaster and the VanAndel Arena box office, or also on the PBR website (www.pbr.com).




LAVOZ JANUARY , RED WITH FLAMES, CHEVY BLAZER LOW RIDER, SECRET OWNER=






Some chronic conditions are caused by a mix of genetic and environmental factors, while other chronic conditions are more directly influenced by diet and lifestyle choices. While not all chronic conditions can be prevented, there are steps that everyone can take that will both lower the risk of being diagnosed with some of the most prominent chronic conditions, and to better manage the symptoms of existing conditions:

- **Check in with your doctor:** Ensure you're keeping regular checkups with your doctor on your schedule and are sticking to the recommended screening schedule for blood pressure, cholesterol and certain cancers.
- **Decrease alcohol use:** Excessive drinking can lead to the development of chronic diseases and other serious problems. Excessive drinking includes binge drinking – consuming four or more drinks on occasion for a woman or five or more drinks on occasion for a man – as well as heavy drinking, which means consuming eight or more drinks in a week for women or 15 or more drinks per week for men.

Improve your diet: Fewer than one in 10 adults and adolescents eat enough fruit and vegetables, while most Americans eat too much sodium and over-consume sugary drinks. By making small changes to your diet like adding more fruits and vegetables, cutting out processed foods and switching to non-sweetened beverages, you can make a significant difference in your long-term health. Visit www.choosemyplate.gov/ for help in building healthy eating habits.

• **Increase exercise:** Most adults and high school-aged students don't get enough physical activity – putting them at a higher risk for heart disease, type 2 diabetes and cancer. Moving just a little bit more can improve your heart health – and doesn't have to mean an intense workout. Moderate-intensity aerobic activities like brisk walking, gardening or biking boost your heart rate

without too much effort, and at least 150 minutes of this kind of activity are recommended per week. Before changing your exercise routine, talk with your doctor.

• **Prioritize sleep:** Rest is essential to supporting your body's systems as you navigate the challenges of everyday life. Insufficient sleep is linked to an increased risk of type 2 diabetes. Adults need at least seven hours of sleep every night. Find tips on how to improve your sleep here.

• **Stop using tobacco:** Tobacco use is linked to an increased risk of the major chronic conditions of cancer, heart disease and diabetes, as well as COPD. Within one year of quitting smoking, your risk of heart disease drops to half of that of someone who still smokes. Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan has resources available to help you quit tobacco.
