Assumption of Risk:

I understand that participation in physical activities involves inherent risks, including but not limited to, the risk of injury, illness, and the potential for aggravation of pre-existing health conditions. I acknowledge that the contests, programs and activities conducted at the Event may involve higher risk exercises that could result in injury.

Health and Fitness Certification:

I hereby certify that I am in good physical condition and have no medical or health-related issues that would prevent me from safely participating in the contests and programs offered at the Event I agree to inform Joel Weeks Legacy Fund of any changes to my health status that may impact my ability to participate in these programs.

Responsibilities of pet owner:

I take full responsibility for the pet attending Joel Weeks Memorial Charity Bowls Day and shall abide by the following requirements:

- All of the information contained in the Registration form is true and accurate;
- I will be in control of my pet at all times while at the event;
- My pet is in good physical condition and has no medical or health-related issues that would prevent it from safely participating in the contests.
- To my knowledge my pet is current on all age-appropriate vaccinations;
- To my knowledge is free of any contagious diseases or conditions;
- My pet is not aggressive;

- My pet is not in heat;
- My pet has not been deemed to be dangerous or potentially dangerous in the past;
- My pet has never caused a problem or injury in a crowded public environment; and
- Event Organizers (including their directors, officials, agents, employees and volunteers), in their discretion, reserve the right to refuse admittance to or eject any unruly, aggressive, unsuitable, or obviously ill pet.
- I have read, understood and shall comply with the event rules (attached).

Release of Liability:

I, on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, hereby waive, release, and discharge Joel Weeks Legacy Fund, its officers, employees, agents, and representatives from any and all claims, liabilities, demands, actions, or causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me, dependants of mine or my pet during or as a result of my participation in the aforementioned activities.

Emergency Medical Treatment Authorization:

In the event of an emergency, I authorize Joel Weeks Legacy Fund, its representatives to seek and consent to emergency medical treatment for me. I understand that efforts will be made to contact me or my emergency contact person prior to any medical treatment.

Photographic and Video Release:

I grant Joel Weeks Legacy Fund and/or its appointed photographer the right to take photographs and videos of me and/or my pet during my and/or my pet's participation in the activities. I understand that non-affiliated individuals or organisations may take photographs and videos of me and/or my pet during my participation in the activities and share them Joel Weeks Legacy Fund. I understand that Joel Weeks Legacy Fund shall use its judgment and discretion to determine the suitability of the content. I understand that these images may be used for media, promotional and educational purposes, and I waive any right to compensation for such use.

Agreement to Follow Instructions:

I agree to follow all instructions provided by Joel Weeks Legacy Fund and its representatives, the programs and activities. I understand that failure to adhere to instructions may increase the risk of injury and may result in my or my pet's removal from the activity.

RULES FOR THE DOG HIGH-JUMP

- This competition is a test of the dog's jumping ability.
- The competition is open to all dogs that are currently registered or classify as a 'working dog'.
- Female bitches that are 'on heat' are not permitted to enter.
- Regulated (dangerous, menacing and restricted) dogs are prohibited from entering.
- The dog is permitted to jump onto, or over the jump.
- All dogs waiting to attempt a jump must be on a lead with a handler in the marshalling area behind the competition area.
- Only one dog may be loose in the competition area at any one time.
- Every dog must compete at every height, until unsuccessful and start together at the same height.
- Each dog is allowed a maximum of three attempts at each height, if necessary.
- Dogs shall be deemed to be unsuccessful if they fail to clear the jump by the 3rd attempt.
- There must be a handler at the top of the jump to act as a catcher if necessary, and a handler as a catcher at the bottom. The dog's owner must supply the handlers. It is considered best practice if at least one of the handlers is over the age of 18.
- Dogs can be encouraged over the jump by a handler, vocally or visually.
- Dogs cannot be assisted by either handler by pushing or pulling the lead or the dog.
- In the event of two dogs jumping the same height, the winner shall be determined as the dog that took the least number of attempts from previous jumps on count back.
- In the event of a dead heat, the prize money shall be shared evenly between all of the winners.
- A dog may compete on a loose lead or must be released at a minimum of three metres from the jump.
- Any mishandling or misuse of a dog will incur immediate disqualification.
- Any dogs that show aggression will be immediately disqualified.
- If in the opinion of the stewards a dog is unsafe to other competitors or the general public, it will be withdrawn from the competition.
- The maximum amount of time allowed for a dog to attempt the jump is 20 seconds from when the dog is called for its turn.
- Once the dog comes within three metres of the jump on any given turn, it will be considered an attempt at the jump, and counted as an attempt.
- Each owner must clean up after their dog and remove any excrement by disposing of it appropriately.
- Each Competitor must complete and sign the Joel Weeks Legacy Fund waiver form, considered the official Entry Form confirming they agree and understand that their dog/s have entered the competition at their own risk and that the conveners and/or their representatives accept no responsibility for any risk or injury, however caused.
