

## SAMPLE TRADE LICENSE REQUIREMENT GUIDE

(This is a sample document for reference only. Subcontractors must provide a valid trade license issued by the appropriate state or local authority.)

### What is a Trade License?

A **trade license** is a government-issued certification that allows a professional to legally perform specialized work within their industry. Many home improvement trades require licensing to ensure compliance with local, state, and federal regulations.

#### Who Needs a Trade License?

If you are performing work in one of the following trades, you may be required to submit a valid trade license before starting work with Element Home Creations:

- ✓ Electrical Contractors Master or Journeyman Electrician License
- ✓ Plumbing Contractors State or County Plumbing License
- ✓ HVAC Technicians Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) License
- ✓ General Contractors Home Improvement License or General Contractor License
- **▼ Roofing Specialists** Roofing Contractor License (if required in your state)
- Other Specialized Trades Elevator Mechanics, Fire Protection Technicians, and other regulated professions

### **How to Provide Your Trade License**

Subcontractors must submit a copy of their valid trade license that meets the following criteria:

- Issued by the appropriate state or local licensing board
- Must be current and not expired
- Must match the business name or individual name performing the work

# **Verification & Compliance**

Element Home Creations reserves the right to verify all submitted trade licenses with the issuing agency. Failure to provide a required license may result in disqualification from working on certain projects.
