

Camping Rules & Regulations



We Welcome campers at Salem Speedway for all our racing events for 2023!

We ask for your cooperation in making this a great experience for everyone involved. To help keep camping FREE at Salem Speedway we ask that you please observe a few rules:

- Salem Speedway assumes no responsibility for loss, theft or damage of individual's private property.
- Camping is for those attending Salem Speedway only. Campers must be able to show proof of ticket purchase to take advantage of FREE camping.
- Camping is allowed in Designated Camping Areas only. Do not camp outside camp boundaries.
- Please Do Not abuse Camping space. <u>Please do not take more space than absolutely</u> <u>necessary for your campsite</u>. No campers allowed on site or saving of spaces more than 4 days prior to event.
- All trash and waste must be removed by camper.
- Salem Speedway property must be vacated by Tuesday at 6 pm following a race.
- Respect those camping around you. Keep music at a lower volume during the late evening hours.
- Keep Pets leashed at all times. NO PETS allowed inside track.
- Please be extra vigilant with campfires during dry and windy conditions.
- Due to insurance regulations Salem Speedway is prohibited fro towing motorhomes, campers, etc. For towing servies call Wilcox Towing 812-883-3888. Towing is at camper's expense.
- Please be aware of carbon monoxide dangers that can be harmful to you or others.
 Vehicle and generator exhaust MUST be expelled safely away from adjacent campsites.
- For Emergency Services call 911 (Fire, Police, or EMS)
- Indiana ATC Regulations prohibit ALCOHOL inside spectator gates.
- Illegal Drugs, Explosives, Sling Shots, Potato Guns or Guns of any type are prohibited. Excessive drunkenness, lewd or obscene behavior is grounds for eviction!
