Before joining Denton County Bass Club (DCBC) we ask that all prospective members read our club By-Laws and Tournament Rules which can be found on our website. Our purpose as a Bass Club organization is to promote the sport of bass fishing and lead by example by adhering to tournament ethics, conservation and youth angling efforts to help promote the sport of bass fishing to future generations. As a member you are expected to, and agree to, abide by the Club By-Laws and Tournament Rules.

In addition to scheduled club tournaments, DCBC members may fish the following venues:

- DCBC members are required to maintain 100% membership with the Bass Anglers Sportsman's Society (BASS) and registered with TX BASS Nation to be able to fish Regional, State and National level events leading to the Bassmaster's Classic
- DCBC members voluntarily agree to maintain membership with FLW TBF to fish the Texas TBF State Qualifier tournaments that lead to the TBF Divisional and National FLW tournament events.

Non Boaters: As a tournament non boater or co angler, you are responsible to communicate with your boater to determine how you will manage fishing time together in an equitable manner. Non Boater and boater provisions must be made for identifying and separating each anglers catch. Your life jacket must be worn and fastened when the combustion engine is running and the boat is under way.

Boaters complete the following:

As a tournament boater you are responsible for compliance with all boat/trailer registration, insurance (B.A.S.S. requires \$300K liability), and safety requirements, water navigation safety, and Coast Guard restrictions. Your boat must be designed with and have a functioning live well which can accommodate you and your non boaters catch. Boater kill switch must be attached to the driver or driver's lifejacket when engine is running and boat is under way.

Annual Club Membership dues are \$90.00 payable upon registration with the Club. \$30 goes to B.A.S.S. Nation, \$30 to Texas B.A.S.S. Nation, and \$30 is club dues to DCBC. Club dues are non refundable, and each member is responsible to maintain his/her B.A.S.S. Membership.

Note: Members joining DCBC after the month of September, will only be required to pay Club fee of \$60 to participate in remaining club tournament schedule. New members intending membership with DCBC as Primary bass club will pay the annual BASS Nation/Club dues of \$90 for the next physical year.
