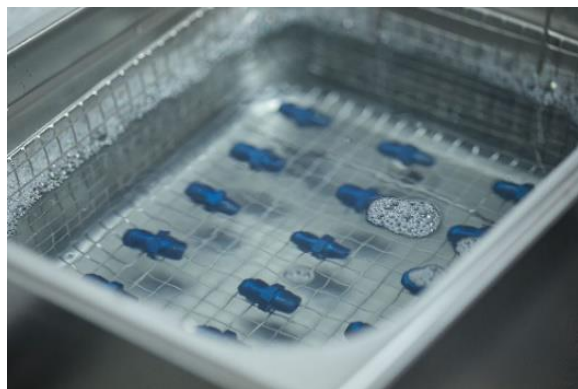

## CLEANING FOR OXYGEN SERVICE

Cleaning for oxygen service is a specialized process that is an essential safety measure required for aircraft oxygen systems.

Presence of contaminants in an oxygen-enriched system could lead to system malfunctions or failures, fires, or explosions.

Components and equipment used in oxygen systems should always be cleaned to industry standards (see below) in order to reduce these hazards.
