Has The World's Biggest Female Movie Star Been Hiding in Plain Sight?

Hollywood Actress Tessa Lyn Calls for Guinness World Record Certification to Confirm Cinema Rebel's Achievement of the World's Largest Motion Picture Performance by a Film Actress of All Time

LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (FEBRUARY 23, 2025) – Hollywood actress Tessa Lyn, displays a full recovery from last year's traumatic news of losing her beloved ex Johnny Wactor to petty crime in LA as she spoke out on Friday at Downtown Los Angeles City Hall to raise awareness on the issue of outdated film laws harming the American People and potentially robbing the American Film Industry of certain global achievements. Tessa Lyn states, "Thomas Jefferson, one of America's founding fathers said, 'I am not an advocate for frequent changes in laws and constitutions. However, laws and constitutions must go hand in hand with the progress of the human mind. When they don't, it is the right of the American People to alter or to abolish it'." Upon Tessa's first romantic break up with Johnny Wactor, in 2017, she ventured off the normal path for a Hollywood actress to explore the capabilities of her iPhone 7 camera and attributes this inspiration to her discovery of 2025 Oscar nominee Sean Baker's film *Tangerine* during the 2015 Sundance film festival.

Tessa became the first female in history to star/direct a feature film on the iPhone for her directorial-debut feature, *Cinema Rebel*, that went on to receive 18 awards and nominations during its short film festival run in late 2022, early 2023, and up to 6 world records still pending certification with Guinness World Records for the unprecedented process Tessa invented to craft the movie, spawning over half a decade. for the first time, become willing to open up on the countless incidents of sexual harassment and gender inequality she experienced from male film producers and talent agents abusing power as the other factors that lead to a decision to quit auditioning, fire a talent manager and explore the iPhone 7 camera.

Hoping to one day bring an end to this corruption, Tessa responded to her career injustices by committing a historic radical self-sacrificial act through self-admittance to what people nickname as "Tessa's 6 year Sentence in Movie Jail." From 2017 to late 2022, Tessa spent the majority of her time

offline, isolated, inside her private home office which functioned as her own production studio where she put in an unfathomable amount of unpaid working hours to learn and execute essentially all roles in all departments required to make a feature film, and did this before AI existed.

These unparalleled achievements and *Cinema Rebel's* anticipated title as the World's Largest Motion Picture Performance, could mean Johnny Wactor's grieving ex, Tessa Lyn, essentially a complete unknown, is the world's biggest movie star and Hollywood's rarest diamond who's been hiding in plain sight. Forged by injustices and corruption, Farrell rises from the ashes in Hollywood and calls America to take a look at history. "Radical self-sacrificial acts of this nature have proven to be successful in causing real and lasting change, as seen in the 1920's women's hunger strike lead by Alice Paul that resulted in a woman's right to vote; or in 1955, when Rosa Park's refusal to rise from a bus seat launched a series of events that lead to the end of racial segregation."

America saw another radical self-sacrificial act by Tessa last year in the release of her emotional plea video where she demanded justice for the murder of her ex Johnny Wactor to ensure his legacy became that of a hero and not a crime victim. Tessa's plea video helped spur the LAPD into swift action to arrest the criminals involved for the crime and inspired Johnny's previous silent family to speak out and transform into passionate political advocates on his behalf. Tessa's plea video came at the cost of enduring unlawful public ridicule when she became a target for online trolls and bullies, as uninformed individuals and negligent reporters distorted facts and spread fabricated negative judgments based on speculative opinions or personal biases, attempting to harm and discredit Tessa, and serve their own interests. *Tessa has not filed suits but has confirmed the above experiences. She may be willing to make exclusive comments.*

Despite being factual and backed with evidentiary support, the Motion Picture Association and Guinness World Records hit a roadblock in the process of certifying *Cinema Rebel's* record titles since Tessa did not have film permits at the time of shooting. Being one of the first people to ever explore the cinematic capabilities of an iPhone camera; Tessa was essentially operating as a film pioneer; creating film content without a crew, script, budget or even an awareness that one day she would use the footage in a feature that would go on to win so many awards. "We now have feature film cameras in our pockets. It is the duty of American institutions and governing bodies to update our laws, policies and regulations to match these technological advancements so American artists can continue to raise the bar creatively and globally. Art is essential to the preservation of our species. It allows us the freedom to express ourselves and explore the holistic intricacies of what it means and how it feels to be alive."

Tessa and the Vital Spark team have made attempts to pay for *Cinema Rebel's* film permits and SAG agreements retroactively, Tessa is even a SAG member herself, but none of the outdated policies have been updated to support these accomplishments and confirm these global unprecedented achievements for the American Film Industry.
