



## PUBLIC IDD SPENDING BY REVENUE SOURCE: FY 2017





### FISCAL EFFORT FOR IDD SERVICES: FY 1977-2017




#### FEDERAL IDD MEDICAID SPENDING BY REVENUE SOURCE: FY 1977-2017









#### **INDIVIDUAL AND FAMILY SUPPORT SPENDING: FY 1987-2017**









# IDD EXPENDITURES AS A PERCENTAGE OF TOTAL SPENDING BY CATEGORY: FY 2017




# TOTAL DAY/WORK AND SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT PARTICIPANTS: FY 1987-2017




# **ESTIMATED NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WITH I/DD BY LIVING ARRANGEMENT: FY 2017**
