Judge Pelikan listened intently then shared with us that he is a man of faith and said, "God speaks to me too." He urged our resident to complete the program and to return to him with her certificate. He also stated that this accomplishment would help guide his decision regarding her sentence.

Redemption Road Church is a faithful church always helping Mission Gate at Promises of Hope Ranch which is home to 24 women and their children. Volunteers, as like many churches serving our ministry, teach life skills classes and supply various needs. Each year a member from Redemption Road Church who owns a tree cutting business, drops wood off at Promises of Hope. Just recently members split and stacked it for our outside Hardy wood stove that we use to heat our homes... the main house and Mary's Promise. Last year, Redemption Road Church built a woodshed to keep our wood dry for burn-

ing. Staff and residents tend to the Hardy every morning. The church's faithful volunteerism will keep the ladies and children warm throughout the winter months and also reduce our heating bill by half!
