

October 10, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Moderator Terry Putnam at 5 pm. and opened with a prayer by Rev. Paul. Due to a short notice change in scheduling, the monthly All-Church meeting was only an Executive Committee meeting. Attendees were: Terry Putnam, Rev. Paul Nesbit, Melanie Nitsch, Eric Nitsch, Bob Franzen, Patty Banasik, Karen Brzezinski, Jen Cotto, and Jim Putnam. A motion was made to approve the Executive Committee Minutes from September 26, 2024, which was passed unanimously.

Pastor

Rev. Paul Nesbit was happy to report that Southwick Community Episcopal Church (SCEC) has moved in. He thanked all who helped make this happen. Upcoming dates to keep in mind:

Treasurer

Jim Putnam reported he has completed a good clean transition from Paychex to Quickbooks for payroll processing. He has been working on using the new on-line version of Quickbooks to produce a new and improved monthly financial statement. Our church banking has been switched over to Westfield Bank including CD investments. Our approximate year-to-date deficit is \$12-15,000, as ex-

Finance

Melanie Nitsch thanked Jim for all his efforts with the Quickbooks conversion. The church will be receiving rental income from Southwick Community Episcopal Church as they share space with us, initially for a 6 mo. period of evaluation with monitoring of any increased expenses and utilities on our part. Melanie will attempt to get a new quote for our church insurance policies to compare to what we pay now. Jim has completed the Underwriter's Renewal Questionnaire and the Workers Comp Annual Audit will be completed soon. Quickbooks will be mailing out church employees' W-2 forms in January. Holly Bazaar reservations are coming in.

Buildings & Grounds

Eric Nitsch thanked Bob Franzen for taking care of a lot of building issues over the summer – sink hole repair, parsonage issues, insulation tasks, etc. The Eversource insulation job is now completed and the church received \$11,000 worth of free insulation that was installed. Rev. Paul mentioned more letters were purchased for the church signs. At the Boy Scout/Girl Scout meeting on 10/7/24, the groups were asked to come up with a service project for our church. Girl Scouts will be asked to help with table set-up for the upcoming Turkey Dinner.

Deacons

Patty Banasik reported they were not able to have a meeting this month due to the short notice of this meeting.

Memorial Gifts

Karen Brzezinski reported working with the Treasurer to change over the Memorial Gift funds to Westfield Bank.

Music

Jen Cotto reported the committee needs to update the organist/choir director contract.

Pastoral Relations

Bob Franzen reported they did not have a summer meeting but one is scheduled for 10/23/24.
