First Ev Lutheran Church Council Minutes – February 21, 2024 @ 7:00 PM

Welcome and Call to Order: President Chris Cordes

Present: Chris Cordes, Erika Aronson, Brad Nesseth, Carmen Nesseth, Tanya Short, Lindsay Short, Elsie Braaten, Tammy Fletcher, Bryana Lothert, Eric Hoversten, Pastor Kris Ferkin, Amy Lee.

Devotions: Brad Nesseth- Genesis 1: 31- We are called to move and also to rest for short periods. God's creation is in motion.

Approve Agenda: Changes to move the youth co-reps report to follow Pastor's report. Motion to approve the agenda with changes: Tanya/Carmen/pass.

Secretary's Report: As printed in the Church Newsletter. Motion to approve the Secretary's report: Erika/Tanya/pass.

Treasurer's Report: January expenses exceeded income by close to \$4000. Worship attendance was down considerably compared to January 2023. Missionary sponsorship commitment in the 2024 budget is \$3500 (down from \$10,500 in 2023). A motion was made by Carmen to continue to support all 3 previously sponsored missionary units, dividing the funds equally 3 ways. Second by Tammy, motion passed. Motion to approve the Treasurer's report: Carmen/Amy/pass

Pastor's Report: 4 Sunday/4 Wednesday worship; 15 visitations including counseling, bereavement, premarital, pastoral care and office visits; 4 children's messages & 4 confirmation classes; 11 meetings including council, staff secretary, text study, education committee, Kenyon area internship committee, interim meeting in Kasson, and the Cannon Rivers Pastors conference. Total mileage: 318.

Youth Rep. Report: The KW actors will perform "The Adams Family" on March 9th and 10th. Elsie Braaten will post informational flyers at the church. There is a discount for tickets purchased in advance. The KW speech team and knowledge bowl team have been active and attending regional events. The KW boys basketball and girls basketball teams are wrapping up their regular seasons this week; the KW wrestling team participated in sections last weekend and were eliminated but wrestling continues as individual sections begin Friday 2/23. Two youth from First Lutheran will be attending the National Youth Gathering in New Orleans this summer. A planning meeting of combined area youth was held at Vang Lutheran on Sunday 2/18. Watch for future fundraising to come.

Continuing and New Business:

- 1. <u>Transition Team update</u>: The transition team's work is complete and the ministry site profile (MSP) is ready to be presented to Barb Streed, assistant to the bishop. The transition team is scheduled to meet with Barb on Tuesday March 12th. The MSP will be sent to the congregation and a town Hall meeting will be scheduled following her review, recommendations, and potential updates. The call committee will activate immediately following that future town hall meeting.
- 2. <u>Farmer's Markets</u>: First Lutheran was approached on behalf of the Kenyon Parks & Rec committee who is asking to again use the parking lot for 2024's Farmer's markets. The markets will be held on the 1st & 3rd Thursday of the Month beginning June 6th and ending October 3rd. Motion to allow the Farmer's Market to be held in First Lutheran's parking lot: Tammy/Carmen/pass
- 3. Changes to meeting agenda, Council procedures, Our Structure book: Pres Chris is reading Our Structure, a book by Rev Brian Hughes about Congregational Leadership. He is interested in exploring potential changes to our meeting structures and agenda writing. He encourages committee members to read the book. Tammy will order 6 copies of the book to belong to First Lutheran and be shared.
- 4. <u>Usher List</u>: Continue to work to create a list of ushers. There is a sign up in the back of the church and Tammy has an old list of interested members. Chris and Tammy will connect with Don Herrlich to work to finalize the list
- 5. <u>Membership List</u>: The stewardship committee is going to work on an updated membership list. Watch for a letter to come from them in March.
- 6. <u>Speakers in front of the church</u>: Fette Electronics is scheduled to come on 2/28 to advise on possible installation of speakers in the altar area of the church to aid those conducting services. Hearing assistance for those in need within the congregation will also be considered.

7. <u>Computer Data Back-up</u>: The tech team is interested in exploring a secure back-up of all First Lutheran business data that may currently be present of multiple different devices. Chris will connect with the tech team to develop a plan to request data.

Committee Reports:

<u>FLCW</u> - Reviewed and discussed changes in the structure of FLCW to combine previous committees into the Mission Action Committee to balance responsibilities. Discussed communion set up, valentine cards, KW choir waffle feed, Lenten suppers, possible summer event, and kitchen cleaning. **FLCW will prepare Palm Sunday Brunch on 3/24**.

<u>Worship/Evangelism</u> - Some Evangelism calls have been made. Discussed possibility of a care team which would provide "ears to the ground" about pastoral care needed. Would need to recruit members. Discussed sign up book- Pastor Kris has agreed to facilitate passing of the book. Confirmands are helping with Wednesday evening Lent services and Pastor Kris is also requesting a cantor. Palm Sunday and Easter needs: plan for kids to march in and out with palms on Palm Sunday, 9 readers needed for Passion Reading on Maundy Thursday (3/28) which will also include first communion for 5th graders. First communion class will be on Saturday 3/23 and the Seder meal on 3/24. Next meeting 3/5 at 5:30 pm.

<u>Property and Management</u> - * Thanked committee members for continued snow and ice removal of walks and parking lot. * Kenyon Farmers Market group has again requested use of our church parking lot on 1st & 3rd Thursdays beginning in June running thru October 3rd. * Looking for framing material to install on Ed Wing wall to continue to display annual pictures of our confirmands. * Looking for materials to replace failing stairwell nosing. * Awaiting visit from Fette Electronics to advise on possible installation of speakers in altar area of church to aid those conducting services. Hearing assistance for those in need within the congregation will also be considered. * Currently have recommendation and cost estimate to refurbish church organ. Have now reached out to a second organ repair company for thoughts and possible estimates as well. * Discussed church kitchen flooring - is it in need of replacement (?) * With storage shed now in place on east side of Ed Wing, look forward to installing rock & edging this spring.

<u>Stewardship</u> - We met to discuss goals and activities for this year. We want to share God's Love through Stewardship and help the congregation associate Stewardship with God's mission rather than just paying the bills. Our February activity was "Souper Bowl of Caring" raising funds for ELCA World Hunger. Thank you to all those that contributed to tackle hunger! \$501.00 was donated. In March we will be composing a letter for our membership update.

<u>Youth and Education</u> - Sunday School students will sing every 4th Sunday; **Intergenerational Activity** in the Fellowship Hall- **February 25th** at 10am. Birthday Bag Packing Party. Donations from the congregation are requested and bags will be delivered to the Kenyon Food Shelf. Lenten soup suppers continue on Wednesdays during Lent, please sign up to help on the sheet in the fellowship hall; **March 17**th-**Intergenerational Bingo**; March 20th- Escape room for 7-12th graders; March 24th- Palm Sunday brunch provided by FLCW needing 7-12th grade volunteers. Activity planning for April-August also begun. Next meeting 3/6 at 6:30 pm.
