Toiletries | Toiletries can be expensive at truck stops. Bringing your own toiletries with you on the road will help you keep fresh and clean.

This includes:

- · Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Toilet Paper
- Soap
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Feminine hygiene items (Feminine Wipes/tampons/pantiliners)

- · Body powder / lotion

Self Care | Showers

Nothing beats a nice shower after a long day behind the wheel. Unfortunately, there are certain drawbacks to driving a truck. Truck drivers, for example, may not be able to shower every day, depending on their location. Since the truck does not have a shower or bathroom, drivers must organize their stops accordingly. Truck drivers can use truck stop showers to clean up after a long day on the road. Although some local truckers are able to sleep at home every night, this is not the case for the majority of over-the-road truckers. Showers at truck stops often cost \$12 to \$20 per person.

Truck Stop Showers

Emergency Supplies | You never know what the weather or road conditions will bring, so you have to be prepared to put up with it for a day or two. Keeping these emergency items in your truck is always a good idea.
