

DIY MINI BOOKSHELF

INSTRUCTIONS

1 What is included:

- One solid "back" layer
- Four "front" layers with cutouts
- Mini book forms
- Assorted miniatures
- Instruction sheet



Additional Supplies Needed:

- Wood Glue
- Craft Glue
- Super Glue
- Strips of Paper
- Acrylic paint or wood stain
- Miniature items for the shelf

Decide what color you want your bookshelf, and set aside one "front" layer to paint or stain. You can also use spray paint!

Flip over one top layer, add wood glue, flip it back over and stick it on top of the solid "back" layer. Line up the pieces so they fit. You can use binder clips or clamps to help them stay. Let dry for 10-15 minutes. Then repeat with the next front layer piece, flipping it and gluing it to the stack. Repeat with four front layers. You now have a stack of four pieces of wood.

Take your painted/stained final front layer, glue it onto the stack the same way you did the others.

Then, cut strips of paper to the size of the book forms. Using craft glue, Cover the book form by wrapping the paper strip around it, leaving one edge visible. Hold Firm. Then trim off extra paper with scissors.



Decorate your bookshelf with small items like beads, dollhouse items, fake flowers, plants. I use superglue to lock items in place. You're done!
