- Be transparent, especially when it comes to board activities and direction of the organization and how we represent members and spend their money.



Channel Philosophy	Rationale
Website and email as primary communication channels.	Cost-effective and immediate; this is increasingly how people expect to get their information.
Minimize printed materials; limit to small, easy to digest materials such as leaflets and postcards with QR codes to access more details.	Eliminate / limit cost and effort to produce and distribute printed materials.
Don't repeat other group's content – link to them when appropriate.	Version control and eliminate cost to update content.
