

Chippewa Flowage Pike Fishing Cheat Sheet

Red areas denote good pike fishing opportunities, especially in May and June.

The daily bag limit for pike is 5. There are no length restrictions.

About these areas:

Most of the areas shown on this map are weed beds. Pike orient to weeds throughout much of the year. Fish in and above the weeds early in the summer and at the edges of the weeds later in summer and into fall.

How to fish these areas:

In early May pike will be very shallow (2-6') and will move deeper by late May and early June (5-10'). This time of the year is the best time to catch pike. Later in summer pike can be deeper.

Baits and techniques:

Crankbaits and spinnerbaits fished above weed beds early in the year works very well. Slip bobbers with minnows are effective all year.
