**OROPHARYNGEAL AIRWAY**

**SUCTION**

<b>Note: The examiner must advise the candidate to suction the patient's airway</b>		
Turns on/prepares suction device	1	
Assures presence of mechanical suction	1	
Inserts the suction tip without suction	1	
Applies suction to the oropharynx/nasopharynx	1	

**NASOPHARYNGEAL AIRWAY**

<b>Note: The examiner must advise the candidate to insert a nasopharyngeal airway</b>		
Selects appropriately sized airway	1	
Measures airway	1	
Verbalizes lubrication of the nasal airway	1	
Fully inserts the airway with the bevel facing toward the septum	1
