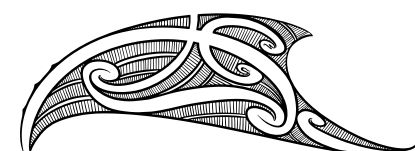
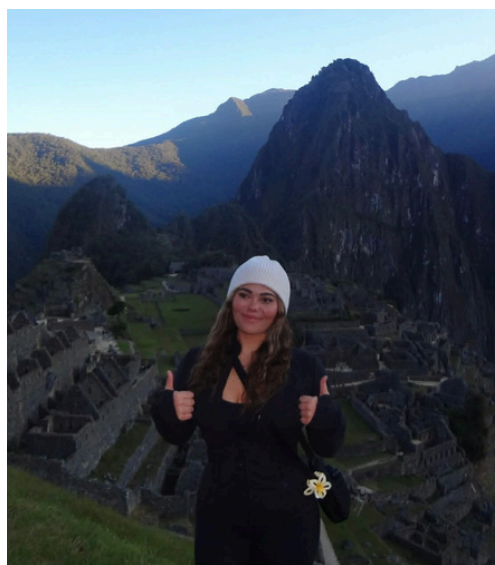
KAUPAPA – TI TALKS

Te Oranga TI Talks is a kaupapa intended to support the final year Trainee Intern Māori medical students to explore potential hospitals they can apply to work at after graduating

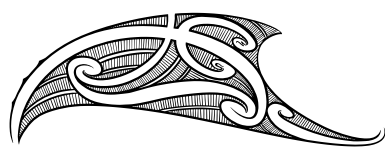
