Corrective and Fashion Color Contract

- All corrective and fashion color is semi-permanent. It will fade. Embrace the fade.
- Some colors last longer than others. Pastels, grays and silvers fade fastest.
- Fashion colors can bleed into each other and into other existing color changing the tone. This is a part of the overall process.
- Making changes to existing fashion/corrective color usually requires lightening (bleach) first. If your hair is not healthy enough for bleach, it is not healthy enough for fashion/corrective colors.
- If there is existing color on your hair, it may take several appointments to achieve the proper "lightness" necessary to achieve your desired result. Removal or lightening of certain colors can be a lengthy process, therefore causing this to be a more expensive service than normal color treatments.
- Please be aware that fashion colors may stain clothing, towels, pillow covers, etc. Take necessary precautions.
- Due to the inherent differences in an individual's hair, it is not possible to guarantee a 100 % perfect match to a certain color, in a photo, for example.

Hair Care Notes/Guidelines:

- It's important that you use the recommended shampoo, conditioner and other products as directed by your stylist.
- Shampoo as little as possible.
- Use cold/cool water to wash your hair.
- Reduce the use of heat (blow dryer, flat iron, etc.).
- NO chlorine (i.e., swimming, hot tubs, etc.).
- *Failing to follow any of the above guidelines will affect the outcome of your color service.*
