

Keratin Smoothing Treatment Aftercare

- Avoid getting your hair wet for the first 72 hours after a Keratin treatment. Use a shower cap when showering and avoid swimming, saunas and steam showers. Hold your hair back even while washing your face and brushing your teeth.
- Always be prepared with an umbrella for rainy days.
- Refrain from tying your hair or tucking it behind your ears to avoid dents. Hats and sunglasses can also make an impression on your hair, so be very careful.
- After the first three days and your first shampoo and condition, it's okay to tie your hair up loosely.
- Avoid chlorine and salt water. This will break down the keratin bond and result in much shorter lasting effects.
- Only use professional keratin hair products purchased from the salon. The salon professional formula gently cleanses and helps maintain the results of your smoothing treatment.
- Coloring your hair can be done the same day, prior to your treatment. Otherwise you must wait a minimum of 2 weeks before coloring your hair.
