# About the Programmes

Three global diploma programmes designed to prepare students for undergraduate-level study and careers in high-demand fields.

## Computing

2 years · 4 semesters · 8 modules · 240 credits

Delivered through written examinations (80%) and practical assignments (20%)

## Global Business

2 years · 4 semesters · 8 modules · 240 credits

Delivered through written examinations (100%)

## Law

2 year · 4 semesters · 8 modules · 240 credits

Delivered through portfolio-based assessment (100%)

- ❑ All programmes share a consistent academic framework. Each module carries **30 credits**. The minimum pass mark is **40%**, with one resit opportunity per failed assessment. No compensation is permitted between modules. All assessments are subject to external examiner oversight via City & Guilds.



# Accreditation & University Progression

## UK Awarding Body Awards

These programmes are designed and awarded by City & Guilds, one of the UK's most established and globally recognised awarding bodies. The qualification is a City & Guilds award — the University of Greenwich is not a co-awarder of the Diploma itself.

## University of Greenwich Articulation

A formal articulation agreement is in place between the programme and the University of Greenwich. Students who successfully complete the Diploma are **guaranteed entry** to the University of Greenwich top-up year — this is not a case-by-case assessment, but a formal commitment supported by a Letter of Support issued by the University.

This pathway gives students and partner institutes a clear, structured route to a **full UK honours degree**.

# Financials & Fees

Partner institutes have full autonomy to set local tuition fees.

## Annual Centre Fee

## Student Registration Fee

Charged annually per enrolled learner — amount to be confirmed

## University of Greenwich Top-up Year Fee

GBP15000 – GBP20000 per academic year

## Moderation & Certificate Costs

All external moderation and certificate costs are covered within the student registration fee. There are no additional charges for these services.

Partial scholarships are available for eligible students, with further details provided during the enrolment process.

# Curriculum Support & Delivery

## What Partner Centres Receive

Partner centres are provided with a full **Scheme of Work** and detailed lesson plans — not simply unit specifications. This ensures consistency of delivery across all authorised centres and reduces the preparation burden on local faculty.

**Internal Verification** of student assignments is managed by the global provider, not the local institute. This is an important quality assurance distinction that protects the integrity of the award and reduces administrative responsibility for partner centres.

All students and local faculty receive full access to the **Virtual Learning Environment (VLE)**, supporting blended delivery, resource sharing, and student engagement.

## English Language Requirements

### Diploma Entry

IELTS 5.5 or equivalent

### University of Greenwich Top-up Year

IELTS 6.0 or equivalent

## Teaching Staff Requirements

All teaching staff are required to hold a minimum of a **Master's degree** in a relevant subject area.

# Progression Pathways & Student Options

Students who complete the Diploma have several clearly defined pathways available to them.



## University of Greenwich Top-up Year

The primary route — progression to the University of Greenwich for the final top-up year, leading to a **full UK honours degree**. The degree certificate is **identical** to that received by on-campus students — there is no reference to online or distance delivery on the certificate itself.



## In-Country Top-up Route

For students who are unable to secure a UK visa, an in-country top-up route is available, delivered via a partner institution. This allows students to complete their degree **without travelling to the UK**.



## Fully Online Top-up

A fully online top-up option is also under consideration — **confirmation of availability is pending** from the University of Greenwich.

**Credit Transfer:** Students wishing to transfer to a different university can request a formal transcript of **240 UK credits**, issued directly by City & Guilds.

# Quality Assurance & Compliance

## Annual Quality Assurance

Quality Assurance audits are conducted annually across all authorised delivery centres. All assessments and marking are reviewed by external examiners through UK Awarding Body, ensuring consistent academic standards regardless of where the programme is delivered.

## Onboarding & Ongoing Support

Partner centres can expect a structured onboarding process, ongoing quality monitoring, and direct support from the programme team throughout the delivery cycle.

## CAS & Visa Sponsorship

For students progressing to the University of Greenwich, the **CAS (Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies)** process is led by the University as the sponsoring institution. Partner centres are expected to support students in preparing the required documentation, but the formal visa sponsorship responsibility sits with Greenwich.

# Summary & Next Steps

These three Foundation Programmes offer partner institutes a comprehensive, well-supported pathway to deliver UK-accredited education at foundation level, with a clear and formally agreed progression route to a University of Greenwich honours degree.



## Accreditation

Awarded by City & Guilds. Formal articulation agreement with the University of Greenwich in place.



## Student Outcomes

Guaranteed progression to University of Greenwich. In-country top-up available. Identical degree certificate to on-campus students.



## Delivery Support

Full Scheme of Work, lesson plans, VLE access, and internal verification support provided.



## Financials

Tuition fees set locally. £15,000–£20,000 indicative range. Partial scholarships available. Moderation and certificate costs included.
