

A Little History



The Skyline Restaurant was the first business built in the city of Satellite Beach, debuting in 1957 at 1462 SR A1A when the latter was a two-lane street. That October, the Soviet Union launched Sputnik I into orbit, triggering the Space Race and the birth of NASA in 1958. These brave men and women were the first residents of Satellite Beach. Buzz Aldrin, one of the first astronauts to walk on the moon, still lives in Satellite Beach.

The building later housed Surf & Turf and Land and Sea Restaurant before Lou Apuzzo took over and renamed it The Cove in 1987. The Cove became a longtime beachside hangout, featuring an outdoor deck, tiki bar, dance club with live music, and dining room
