FINANCE REPORT

The financial status of Post 201 is good. The balances as of January 31, 2023 are as follows: Checking - \$39,036.70, Savings - \$28,255.60, CDs -\$5260, Loan Balance - \$26,159.49.

We did have a good 2022 despite some expenses. A major one was a new roof for the Legion building and shed. While the cost exceeded \$38,000 for the new roofs our insurance took care of the major part of the costs. This was a result of the major storm in December 2021.

In addition to the new roofs, we made some major purchases in the kitchen: two years ago we replaced the dishwasher, recently replaced 3 fryers and double door refrigerator, and there have been a few other minor expenses.
