


NATIONAL LOTTERY APPLICATION

The aim of this group is to help our club can take the first steps \searrow towards a more sustainable existence. The group will:

- educate our members allowing ownership of the sustainability of the site.
- Install & design environmental signage around our pitch.





- Work with the <u>Friends of Duncan's Dam</u> to carryout regular litter picking events at the dam and within the local area.
- Facilitate and offer <u>guided nature walks in Duncan's Dam</u> facilitated by council's biodiversity officer and NIEA experts.

We have received $\bigotimes \pm 1,500 \bigotimes$ in <u>funding</u> from the <u>'Live Here Love Here'</u> small grants scheme in collaboration with Lisburn and Castlereagh City Council who provide the funding. We will:

- O Purchase litter pickers, gloves and hi-vis vests for the group.
- Install a bike rack for the site to aid and encourage members to travel sustainably and the eco club will raise the profile of sustainable travel through the year.
- Install biodiversity planters on the site filled with native wildflowers.



FINANCE UPDATE

The main source of funding for our club is via membership. This financial year has seen membership increased z significantly to 500 members! ✓ This is a fantastic achievement for the club.

The other main source of income for the club is from the **"100 cub"** lotto which generates a net profit of £5-6k per annum.

Prize money was increased in January, however with just a few new members this would increase prize money even further without impacting on the club income.

This year increased sponsorship as well as access to more Grant funding has ensured that the club are currently projecting a significant surplus for this financial year.

This will enable future investment in the club!
