Our Engagement Strategy

Increasing student engagement is tricky. At PCT, we aim to develop the students' passion for learning and gaining a greater interest in their futures. Students are engaged when they are involved in their work, persist despite challenges and obstacles, and take visible delight in accomplishing their work.

We recognise when student engagement has improved when we experience the student's willingness, need, and desire to participate and contribute to the learning process, promoting higher level thinking for enduring understanding.

We will work with the student to develop their self-awareness and some of the root causes of their current situation. We utilise mental health and wellbeing assessment tools to establish a baseline in which to move forward. In addition, our engagement questionnaire helps to ascertain their level of psychological investment into learning and commitment to positively change their mindset.

We encourage the student to work with their mentor to develop a clear roadmap together, laying down a route which can progress them from where they are today and where they want to get to in terms of their personal, academic, career and life goals.

Their roadmap will provide the basis of an individual learning plan (ILP), to outline what they need to work on and celebrate their successes, providing achievable milestones and rewards along the way. Throughout their journey, they will develop self-awareness and mindfulness skills to make better and informed decisions that will be sustainable

Our Teaching Approach

We recognise that everybody is different and when it comes to learning, one method does not fit all. That is why we determine students' learning style (e.g., visual, auditory and kinaesthetic) by means of an assessment carried out upon starting the course in order to adapt our teaching approach towards their learning preferences.

In addition to academic support, we put great value on the mental health and personal wellbeing of our students. By working collaboratively with the schools, our Coventry City Council partners and other agencies, we ensure the student receives a holistic approach to supporting their needs, giving them the best chance of achieving their goals. Our courses adopt several strategies and techniques, that include:

We believe it's important to develop sincere, authentic relationships to build trust between staff, students, and their peers. When we experience an open channel for communication, we are more likely to share their feelings and be honest

Our Courses

All our courses include meals and refreshments for students, learning materials and teaching resources including the use of IT at the centre. Each course is for a 6-week period and may comprise of 2, 3 or more days per week. Although not all courses will be available all week round, we will always try our best to accommodate for each individual and offer a flexible timetabling system to try and promote inclusivity.

The core curriculum GCSE courses cover all course content outlined in the National Curriculum and are carried out at our learning centre in small groups. We can offer courses with or without accreditation.

As soon as a student is enrolled onto one of our courses, they will be required to complete a baseline assessment. This assessment will highlight gaps in knowledge and assist in prioritising a unit schedule for the teaching period.

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Vocational (6-week ASDAN)

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English Language

Overview

Proficient use of the English language provides the foundation on which all other learning is built. The student will learn essential skills they need to read, understand, and analyse a wide range of different texts covering the 19th, 20th and 21st century time periods. In addition, this course will develop their skills to write clearly, coherently and accurately, using a range of vocabulary and sentence structures.

The successful completion of this course, final exams and spoken language assessment will result in achieving one GCSE. This course and qualification provide the student with the essential requirement for most employers and education institutes. The course provides an excellent knowledge base in English language and is compulsory for students who are planning to go onto A levels. It's ideal for anyone aspiring to achieve a career involving English such as journalism, copywriting, teaching or editing.

Overview

Achievement of this qualification will provide evidence of students' achievements against demanding and fulfilling content. Students will gain the confidence that the mathematical skills, knowledge and understanding that they will have acquired throughout this course are as good as those of the highest performing jurisdictions in the world.

Successful completion of the GCSE maths course will equip students with a strong foundation for further academic and vocational study, giving students the appropriate mathematical skills, knowledge and understanding to help them progress to a full range of courses and jobs. This includes Level 3 mathematics courses as well as Level 3 and undergraduate courses in other disciplines such as biology, geography and psychology, where the understanding and application of mathematics is crucial.

Overview

This GCSE Combined Science: Trilogy course covers Biology, Chemistry and Physics. The successful completion of this course and final exams will result in achieving 2 GCSEs. This course and qualification provide the student with a strong foundation to further study at A Level or to progress into a scientific-based apprenticeship. It's ideal for anyone aspiring to move into a career that involves science, such as medicine, veterinary, pharmaceuticals, research and development.

Lessons are delivered to small classes (a maximum of 8 students) to ensure students are exposed to the required practical activities, they will attend a separate laboratory session – one day per month (minimum) – to develop their use of apparatus and scientific techniques. Each student will have their own lab book to keep a clear record of what they have covered to avoid duplication and to make handover easier and more effective.

ASDAN Short Courses are flexible, portfolio-based programmes designed to accredit up to 60 hours of activity and skills development across a range of topics and curriculum areas. We have selected a range of course to meet the students need under Lot 1 provision with Work Related Learning (WRL). Additional courses can be requested through Lot 6 Bespoke Provision.

Vocational Tasters are multi-level, meaning that the focus is on completing challenges and skills development according to individual ability, rather than attainment at a specific level.

These courses are offered as a 6-week programme for 2 days per week. Programmes can count as half of the curriculum credits (six) required for the CoPE qualification at Levels 1 and 2.

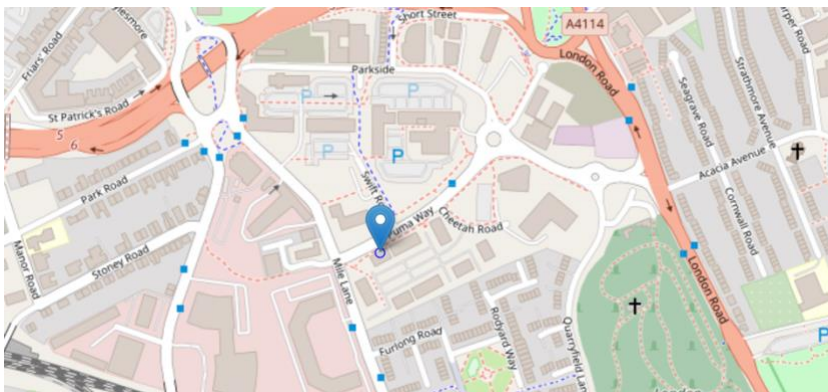
