New Organ: Our Music Director, Marvin Olsen attended our Council meeting to let us know of an opportunity to obtain an organ from the Whitewater UCC church. The church unfortunately has closed, and they offered theirs to replace our 35-year-old Galanti Praeludium. The organ is a 2013 Model Q390 Allen Electronic organ. The Council approved the donation by Whitewater UCC for the organ, and they accepted! Work is being done now through Yerges Van Lines and Metro Sound to get the organ moved to our location. New speakers and a dedicated sound system will be installed. The current one will be sold. We look forward to many years of beautiful organ music!

The weather turned nice just in time and we used pails, "grabbers", gloves, and "Green Core" trash bags for our "garbage hunt."
