Sunday, October 1st, 2023 (10/1) is all about canning the shame of cannabis consumption. We chose October 1st to celebrate because on this same day in 1937 The Marihuana Tax Act was instituted. This taxation, introduced by Harry Anslinger, essentially made the sale and possession of all Hemp and Hemp derived products illegal through extreme taxation. Anslinger and his friends used inflammatory propaganda to get his bill pushed through, and thus cannabis shame was created in society. We have come to add another dimension to the story, and push to “can the shame” of cannabis consumption.

CannaShame Awareness Day 2023 this year includes infused food and drinks, a sponsored Smoke Room, vending, a live CannaShame Podcast recording and live stream, and more!

The Network

The CannaShame Network was started by founders Yolanda Bennett and Angela Weston in 2021.
