HOA BOARD OF DIRECTORS & HOMEOWNER'S MEETING MINUTES
Thursday, March 19, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am by President Mark Rolfes. Board Members present: Mark Rolfes, George Krilles, Don Berghauser, Karen Halasz, Sue Johnson, Doug Gasparick, Marie Chavez, Sheila Dubbink, and Bob Robinson. A moment of silence was observed for those who have passed in the past month. The minutes from the February 19, 2026 meeting were approved.

Items Discussed:

1. President Mark Rolfes reviewed three issues concerning our Community Water water system. The company needs to construct a new well in our RV storage area. Pueblo Estates will have to make a significant space available for well construction. A smaller space will be given up permanently for the new well. Water main easements and fire hydrants have been impacted by resident construction over the years. These problems need to be considered. Finally, the water main for Via Frondosa will be relocated from the back alley into the street in the near future. This construction will impact Frondosa residents.
2. Mark thanked residents who have been supporting community activities. There will only be two more board meetings before summer, so issues should be addressed now.
3. Conformance – Weeds in yards and alleys need to be taken care of. Help out your neighbor if you are able.
4. Architectural – A lot of building applications are coming in. Marie is trying to consolidate our storage areas.
5. Financial – The monthly report is available. Accounts receivable has been decreasing as more charges are paid. Next meeting will be the end of the fiscal year. There will be no HOA fee increase for 2026.
6. RV Lot – More rat poison will be used around the lot. New cameras are being installed. Work on the new gate and light rewiring continues.
7. Communications – There has not been much input for the April Topics. Sue thanks those who helped out with events.
8. Kitchen – The kitchen has served well for big events. Kitchen up-grades are being considered, starting with a triple sink and new cupboards.
9. Clubs – All goes well with our clubs. A new Welcoming Committee is being formed.
10. Landscape – Weeds are a problem around the community this time of year. Oleanders are being cut back at the RV lot.
11. Resident Comments – Seven residents spoke at the board meeting. Concerns included issues at the pool, questions about why the General Purpose room needs to be locked, and the possibility of mounting a hand-made cloth wall-hanging in the clubhouse.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 am.


If you have unopened items you would like to share with the community, you may place them on the bench outside the clubhouse (non-perishables, fruits, and vegetables only).







FEVER IN THE HEARTLAND
Timothy Egan
APR. 2, 2 PM, P.E. LIBRARY

The Roaring Twenties--the Jazz Age--has been characterized as a time of Gatsby frivolity. But it was also the height of the uniquely American hate group, the Ku Klux Klan. Their domain was not the old Confederacy, but the Heartland and the West. They hated Blacks, Jews, Catholics and immigrants in equal measure, and took radical steps to keep these people from the American promise. And the man who set in motion their takeover of great swaths of America was a charismatic charlatan named

D.C. Stephenson. Stephenson was a magnetic presence whose life story changed with every telling. Within two years of his arrival in Indiana, he'd become the Grand Dragon of the state and the architect of the strategy that brought the group out of the shadows – their message endorsed from the pulpits of local churches, spread at family picnics and town celebrations. Judges, prosecutors, ministers, governors and senators across the country all proudly proclaimed their membership. But at the peak of his influence, it was a seemingly powerless woman – Madge Oberholtzer – who would reveal his secret cruelties, and deathbed testimony finally brought the Klan to their knees.



THE PRINCE OF FROGTOWN

Rick Bragg closes his circle of family stories with an unforgettable tale about fathers and sons inspired by his own relationship with his ten-year-old stepson. He learns, right from the start, that a man who chases a woman with a child is like a dog who chases a car and wins. He discovers that he is unsuited to fatherhood, unsuited to fathering this boy in particular, a boy who does not know how to throw a punch and doesn't need to; a boy accustomed to love and affection rather than violence and neglect; in short, a boy wholly unlike the child Rick once was, and who longs for a relationship with Rick that Rick hasn't the first inkling of how to embark on. With the weight of this new boy tugging at his clothes, Rick sets out to understand his father, his son, and himself.

The Prince of Frogtown documents a mesmerizing journey back in time to the lush Alabama landscape of Rick's youth, to Jacksonville's one-hundred-year-old mill, the town's blight and salvation; and to a troubled, charismatic hustler coming of age in its shadow, Rick's father, a man bound to bring harm even to those he truly loves. And the book documents the unexpected corollary to it, the marvelous journey of Rick's later life: a journey into fatherhood, and toward a child for whom he comes to feel a devotion that staggers him.
