Our members have been working diligently to prepare for the **Annual Ceramics Club Sale**, which is scheduled in the Ceramics Room on **Saturday**, **November 1**, **2025** from 9 am to 1 pm.

The proceeds from the Annual Ceramics Club Sale allow us to purchase new molds, paints, and supplies for the club. The sale also helped the club to purchase a new kiln (with additional funding from the HOA) in June 2025. The new kiln has been installed and is working out really well. We are so pleased with the new kiln and have been firing lots of new ceramics.

The newer molds include many gnomes, Christmas trees, turtles, rabbits, owls, and other fun molds. So many fun new molds to pour, clean, fire, paint and take pride in our projects.

Membership in the club is only \$20.00 per year and this includes the use of all of the molds, paints, glazes, firings, etc. Members pay for the ceramic slip, which the club purchases and sells to members at cost. Anyone living in the Pueblo Estates HOA are eligible for membership; Guests may visit and join us for \$5.00 per week. Our Ceramics room will accommodate 12 members at a time; many members come early or late to allow for additional seating at the tables.

New members receive instruction and are educated to the various processes involved in making projects. Several of our members have extensive experience in ceramics and are more than happy to assist new members and teach them.

If you have a "creative" mind, please come join us. And if you don't have a "creative" mind, join us anyway and get inspired. It's very pleasant atmosphere and cheery banter while letting your creative juices flow; It is a great way to spend your time.




KILLERS OF A CERTAIN AGE DEANNA RAYBOURN NOV. 6, 2 PM P.E. LIBRARY
