Cactus Care Instructions

Watering

When you water, soak the roots thoroughly!

- 90° & above: Water once a week
- 80°: Water once every two weeks
- 70°: Water once every three weeks
- Dec.-Jan.: supplemental water is usually not necessary.

When cacti are flowering in summer, give them an extra drink!

Feeding

Fertilize monthly March through August.

Optional treatments for grubs and insects is best done twice per year using a systemic insecticide mixed with fertilizer.

Weathering

Most cacti are hardy to 25°.

Cover top of plant to protect the growth area on freezing nights. Don't leave the covering on plant for whole season.

The most important item to have with you when going out to check for mail or taking out trash is a flash lite! Anti-Venom vials at this time are about one thousand dollars each. Baby Rattlesnakes can deliver a bite that may require up to four vials. A bite from an adult may require up to thirty or even forty vials. Medical insurance does not always cover the cost.

PAGE 3

- 4a. Shrubs, trees and plant locations, new or replacement, must be approved by the Board or Architectural Committee to ensure that such plants do not interfere with any person's line of sight while traversing the roadways within the Property. Properties that have fruit trees will promptly pickup all fruit that has dropped from trees before such fruit becomes a health or a safety hazard. If owner is gone for a period of time, he or she must make arrangements to have the dropped fruit removed regularly.
- 4c. No fence or wall may be more than <u>four (4)</u> feet higher than the ground level of the Lot measured at the street side(s) of the Lot, and not more than <u>six (6)</u> feet higher than the ground level of the Lot measured at the back and sides of the Lot. The back side of your house is facing the easement. The sides of your house are the parallel sides that border your neighbors' lot or the street if you're on the corner lot. The sides of your house are considered to run from the easement to the street. The front of your house is the part of your lot that faces the Street side of your property, contains the entrance to your carport and runs from side to side.

All new Chain-link fences as of this date of revision will be limited to the rear of the lot facing the easement. Corner lot wall must consist of the following: Adobe block, concrete block (finished with Stucco) or masonry slump block.

PAGE 6

Each homeowner is allowed one (1) patio sale per calendar year. If a homeowner is moving. he/she may also have one (1)" moving sale" No carport (patio) sale may be conducted for more than two (2) consecutive days. (NO carport (patio) sales allowed on Thursday due to garbage pick-up. All parking must be limited to parking on one side of the street to allow for access by emergency vehicles. The PEHOA must be notified of all sales.

PAGE 7.

- 11. Owners shall limit parking on their lots to operable vehicles that are wheeled, self-propelled or motorized, not in excess of 235 inches in length bumper to bumper, nor more than seven (7) feet in height, and normally intended for street or highway use. Such vehicles, which include, but are not necessarily limited to, automobiles, vans, golf carts, motorcycles, UTV's, ATVs, and pickup trucks, shall be parked only in the owner's <u>carport garage</u>, <u>driveway</u>, <u>or covered patio</u>, but not less than seven (7) feet from the curb line. <u>They may not be parked on the street</u>, <u>set back areas</u>, or on other's property without permission from the other owner. Vehicles parked on property belonging to the owner of the vehicle may not constitute a nuisance or an annoyance to the neighborhood or the community. Parking of any vehicles at night on Pueblo Estates streets, including La Canoa, is prohibited. Golf carts are only <u>permitted</u> to be parked under cover not in side pull-outs or yard. RV owners see Number 11a.
- 11a. Trailers, house trailers, tent trailers, watercraft with or without trailers, aircraft, recreational vehicles and similar vehicles shall not be parked on any lot, but may be stored in the RV Storage Center provided by Association as space in this facility permits. Long term inactive storage of these vehicles shall not be permitted; such inactive storage shall be defined as non-usage of any of these vehicles during a one-year period.
