With the coming of September we will see the resuming of many activities that do not happen in the hotter months. Please check the Topics for times and dates.




PROTECT-OUR-PIPES PROJECT - GREASE COLLECTION

Drop your grease off at our year-round collection site

Pouring grease into your drain puts you and your household at risk of severe plumbing problems, including clogged pipes and sewer backups. Thus, it's important to keep grease, oils, fats, and similar substances out of your plumbing system.

Every January, the Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department holds a countywide grease drive to encourage people to bring and drop off their used cooking grease and oil. But if you missed this year's event, you don't have to hold on to your grease until next year.

You can always bring your grease to our permanent

collection site, located at Agua Nueva Water Reclamation Facility at 2947 W. Calle Agua Nueva in Tucson. The site is open Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

All of the collected grease will be recycled into biodiesel, a cleaner-burning fuel than regular diesel. Not only will you be protecting your pipes by keeping grease out of your drain, but you'll be helping out the planet as well!




I realize that it is only September, but last year we did over 60 houses as well as the common areas, the main entrance, and around the clubhouse and we need to get started before Thanksgiving.
