Thursday, February 19, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am by President Mark Rolfes. Board Members present: Mark Rolfes, George Krilles, Don Berghauer, Karen Halasz, Sue Johnson, Doug Gasparick, Marie Chavez, and Sheila Dubbink. Bob Robinson was absent. A moment of silence was observed for those who have passed in the past month. The minutes from the January 15, 2026 meeting were approved.

Items Discussed:

1. President Mark Rolfes thanked the outgoing board members for all their hard work during their time served on the Board. He introduced our two new members – Marie Chavez and Sheila Dubbink.
2. Board members were assigned new assignments and backups.
3. Conformance Complaints – All complaints must complete a Complaint Form and sign it. The HOA does not divulge the complainer; however, it cannot be made confidential as per Arizona law.
4. Architectural – Any change to the appearance of a house on the outside must be approved by the Architectural committee.
5. Placita Del Laurel will be repaved. March 4th is scheduled for removal of asphalt and repaving is scheduled for March 6th.
6. Financial – The monthly financial reports are posted on the bulletin board outside the kitchen.
7. RV Lot – The power between poles shorted out. A new line is to be installed as well as a new gate and some cement repaving at entrance way. Three new cameras have been installed.
8. Kitchen – Please do not drop off personal food items to the kitchen. All food supplies are purchased based on the need of the special event.




WE WILL BE JAGUARS
NEMONTE NENQUIMO
MAR. 5, 2 PM, P.E. LIBRARY

Born into the Waorani tribe of Ecuador's Amazon rainforest—one of the last to be contacted by missionaries in the 1950s—Nemonte Nenquimo had a singular upbringing.

She was taught about plant medicines, foraging, oral storytelling, and shamanism by her elders. At age fourteen, she left the forest for the first time to study with an evangelical missionary group in the city. Eventually, her ancestors began appearing in her dreams, pleading with her to return and embrace her own culture. She listened.

Two decades later, Nemonte has emerged as one of the most forceful voices in climate change activism. She has spearheaded the alliance of indigenous nations across the Upper Amazon and led her people to a landmark victory against Big Oil, protecting over a half million acres of primary rainforest. Her message is as sharp as a spear—honed by her experiences battling loggers, miners, oil companies and missionaries.
