Pre 2024

Inconsistent Food Supply

- Orphanage was fully reliant on monthly donations for food purchases.
- Experienced recurring food shortages.
- Orphans and staff often had only two meals/day.
- Sometimes ran out of food.
- Staple food source is maize (corn) meal.







Desired Situation



Food Sustainability Initiative

Phase 1: Purchase farmland (completed spring 2024)

- After a successful fundraising effort, in 2024 ten acres of farmland was purchased to eliminate annual lease costs.
- When the crops are successful, land produces enough food staples to ensure three meals/day.
- Provides children with hands-on vocational training on farming.
- Also provides an ongoing revenue stream for orphanage support through sale of any surplus produce.
- Unfortunately, relying on rainfall to water the crops means some seasons the crops fail (like spring 2024).






Orphanage Food Sustainability Initiative Phase 2: Irrigation

Fundraising Goal: \$12,000

- \$5,500 to perform hydrogeological survey, drilling, and well development.
- \$6,500 to purchase and install the water pump, solar, batteries, water tanks, pipes, and plumbing accessories.








