VISITOR AND GUEST POLICIES

Definition of a Visitor A visitor is:

- A member in good standing of a private golf club, country club, or racquet club who is using the Club's facilities as a reciprocal. The visitor is extended full Club privileges. Visitors are required to register in the guestbook provided in the receptionist office.
- An individual who is participating in an event sponsored at UBG&CC who is not the guest of a member.
- Responsible for any indebtedness incurred at UBG&CC

Definition of a Guest A guest is:

one who occasionally accompanies a UBG&CC member in good standing. There are two kinds of guests:

- Off-island: does not own property, rent, or reside on Whidbey Island
- On-island: Owns property, rents, or resides on Whidbey Island

The member is responsible for:

- Registering the guest in the member services office
- Their guest's conduct, including adhering to our dress code, and indebtedness.

Guest privileges for clubhouse gaming (e.g., bridge, Mahjong, poker, etc.)

- Privileges can be issued to off-island guests for a maximum of two consecutive weeks with a yearly limit of three instances per individual guest
- On-island guests are limited to one visit per month
- All guests may use the dining and bar facilities with a member as often as they are invited

The Board has the right to determine which activities and events are open to members only, if there is a guest fee and the amount, and to change the amount and guest access at any time

Pool Privileges

Guest:

- Three (3) guests per membership
- 17 and younger \$6 | 18 and older \$10
- Member must check-in guest(s)

Tennis, Pickleball and Bocce Privileges

No Reciprocal Privileges for members of other clubs

o Pickleball and Bocce courts are available for use by Proprietary, Senior, Junior Executive, Social and Colony Clubhouse Members ONLY.

Guest:

- Play only in the company of the inviting/sponsoring member
- Payment of guest court fees for each guest on each occasion (\$10)
- Members may have up to three (3) guests at one time
- A guest who does not own property, rent, or reside on Whidbey Island may play as many times as he or she is sponsored by a member, except June 1 through August 31, during which time he or she may play only twice per calendar month.
- A guest who owns property, rents, or resides on Whidbey Island may play no more than five (5) times per year, with a limitation of one time per calendar month between June 1 and August 31.
- Lineal descendants and their spouses or parents of any Proprietary Member with a limit of four (4) times per month.

Golfing Privileges

Reciprocal

- Subject to tee time availability.
- Payment of reciprocal green fees.
- Allowed to play one (1) round of golf per month on a reciprocal basis.

Guest

- Play only in the company of the inviting member.
- Payment of guest green fees.
- From May 1st to September 30th, members may have up to three guests at one time, with the exception of all day on Fridays, and prior to 2pm on weekends and holidays in which only one guest per member is permitted.
- A guest who does not own property, rent, or reside on Whidbey Island may play as many times as he or she is sponsored by a member, except June 1st through August 31st, during which time he or she may play only two (2) rounds per month
- A guest who owns property, rents, or resides on Whidbey Island may play no more than five (5) times per year, with a limitation to one (1) 18-hole round or two (2) 9- hole rounds per calendar month between June 1st to August 31st.

• Lineal descendants and their spouses or parents of any Proprietary Member with a limit of four (4) times per month.

Rounds played in an outside event that are hosted at, but not sponsored by UBG&CC do not count toward the monthly allotted round(s)

Guests are not permitted to use the fitness facility
