*YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROJECT (YEP)*

Youth Employment Project (YEP) is a Resume Writing Class for young ladies and young men. The class covers : Resume Writing, Cover Letters, Thank You Letters, Reference Pages, as well as Customer Service / Interviewing Training, and Goal Setting. From January 2018 to May 2018, 21 students enrolled in the class while 17 students completed the class and its entirety. At the end of to session, participants received Certificates of Completion and Portfolios. With support of our fundraising sponsor, Lincoln Heiser Ford along with Cargill Cares, YEP has launched a new program. In January 2019, three prior students of ODB will receive \$500 Scholarships for college/trade school. More details will be listed on ourdailybreadmil.org on December 3, 2018.

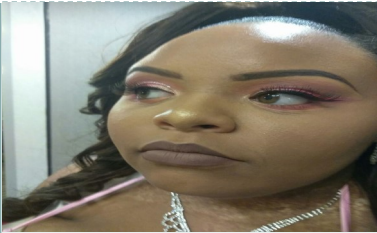
## FOSTERING HIGHER EDUCATION
